Tour Description

There's more to Iceland than cold winters – take to the open road in summer and explore black sand beaches, dramatic waterfalls and imposing glaciers. Or, head into the wilderness and witness the midnight sun.

Reykjavik on the coast of Iceland, is the country's capital and largest city. It's home to the National and Saga museums, tracing Iceland's Viking history. The striking concrete Hallgrímskirkja church and rotating Perlan glass dome offer sweeping views of the sea and nearby hills. Exemplifying the island's volcanic activity is the geothermal Blue Lagoon spa, near the village of Grindavík.

Day 1: Arrive in Reykjavík, Orientation tour of Reykjavík.

Velkominn til Iceland! – Reykjavík. On arrival in Keflavík airport clear immigration collect your bags & meet your tour manager outside the baggage hall.

- Board coach and transfer to the hotel check into hotel.
- Evening proceed for orientation tour of the city. Later in the evening proceed for dinner.
- Overnight hotel in Reykjavík. (Meal Plan: Dinner)

Day 2: Guided tour of Golden Circle, Visit to Fríðheimar (Tomato Farm)

- After the breakfast embark on a full day tour to discover the natural wonders of the Golden Circle including the Gullfoss waterfall an iconic waterfall of Iceland offering a spectacular view of the forces and beauty of untouched nature, The water plummets down 32 meters in two stages. Strokkur geyser a single burst reaching a height of up to 30 meters almost every 10-12mins
- Þingvellir National Park, the site of the world's oldest parliament & the meeting place of North America and European tectonic plates. A UNESCO world heritage site.
- Visit to Fríðheimar see an exhibition about horticulture in Iceland. Then you can take delicious memories home with you, because now there are food souvenirs for sale in Fríðheimar, such as tomato jam, cucumber salsa and tomato juice. Enjoy the enjoy unique lunch experience, where tomatoes grow all year round! Tomato soup and freshly baked bread along with other delicacies in a pleasant environment within the tomato plants.
- Overnight hotel in Reykjavík. (Meal Plan: Breakfast/lunch/Dinner)

Day 3: Blue Lagoon Tour

- Proceed to Blue lagoon for a chance to enjoy your comfort package, a unique bathing experience in the mineral rich waters. Enjoy steamy views of this spectacular geothermal spa. On return to Reykjavik proceed for dinner.
- Overnight hotel in Reykjavik.(Meal Plan: Breakfast/lunch/Dinner)

Day 4: City tour of Reykjavik, Visit to Hallgrimskirkja

- After breakfast in the hotel, a local guide will lead on a sightseeing tour of Reykjavik by private coach. Visiting these cultural attractions in Reykjavik will signal the start of your exciting quest to learn about the history of Iceland! During the tour you will see Bessastaoir; the official residence of the president of Iceland; the Icelandic Parliament, City Hall, the Lutheran Cathedral (Domkirkjan), the Catholic Cathedral of Christ the King, and Reykjavik's colorful Old Harbor. During the city tour of Reykjavik you will also visit the futuristic Perlan to take advantage of the amazing, panoramic views it offers of the city.
- Visit Iceland's most iconic church: Hallgrimskirkja. The church's design was meant to resemble lava flows, and its steeple has become a true landmark in Reykjavik's Old Town. Another exciting inclusion on the tour is a visit to the Settlement Exhibition, whose collection of Viking artifacts dates back to 871 AD when Reykjavik was first settled by Vikings from Norway. Your last stop today will be at the Culture House to see its impressive collection of Icelandic works of literature, including some of the medieval, calfskin manuscripts of the Icelandic Sagas. Enjoy an evening at leisure in Reykjavik.
- Overnight hotel in Reykjavik.(Meal Plan: Breakfast/lunch/Dinner) .
