Day wise detailed Itinerary

DAY 1: Arrival in London, the capital of the United Kingdom and a global financial center. Panoramic tour of London.

• Welcome! Today we board our flight to one of the most beautiful cities London. London is one of the world's most famous capital cities and England's largest city, offering an endless number of attractions, museums, historical buildings, and entertainment options. London can be an overwhelming city for many visitors, especially those visiting for the first time.

- On arrival check into the hotel and relax in the comfort of the hotel.
- In the evening we proceed for a panoramic city tour of London. We will See St. Paul's Cathedral, Big Ben, Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Buckingham Palace, and many more sites.
- Overnight stay in London (Meal Plan –Dinner)

DAY 2: Guided city tour of London with changing of guards at Buckingham Palace. Guided tour of Tower of London.

- City tour with our expert local guide covering important landmarks like Hyde Park, the Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, Buckingham Palace, Tower Bridge, Witness the changing of guards (subject to operational).
- We will also see Tower Bridge, one of London's most famous landmarks, is a bascule and suspension bridge on River Thames.
- Entrance to Tower of London with Local Guide. The Tower's origins date back to the 11th century, and today it is an official UNESCO World Heritage Site. Inside you can see the Crown Jewels, which have been on display here since the 17th century, and the Highlight of the visit is the world-famous Kohinoor Diamond in the Jewel House.
- The tour will finish in the city center, and the rest of the day is free to shop or explore the city at leisure on their own.
- Overnight stay in London. (Meal Plan Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

DAY 3: Cruise on River Thames. Ride the London Eye. Visit the famous Madame Tussauds wax museum.

- We proceed to Pier to take a Panoramic cruise on the river Thames. See more of the city's landmarks in less time and enjoy a memorable view of the city on a Thames river cruise.
- We will board the London Eye, which is a cantilevered observation wheel on the South Bank of the River Thames in London. It is the most popular paid tourist attraction in the United Kingdom. Get splendid views of the city while you ride the London eye at a slow speed for 30 minutes.
- Visit the renowned Madame Tussauds wax museum. Be enthralled by the world's largest wax collection of famous personalities and historical figures, as well as popular film, sports, and television characters.
- Overnight stay in London. (Meal Plan Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

DAY 04: Euro star Arrival in Brussels, the capital of Belgium and headquarters of the

European Union and NATO.

• We proceed for an Orientation tour of Brussels. During the tour group will visit one of Europe's most beautiful squares, the Grand Place, which is home to the medieval Town Hall.

• Photo stop at fabled MannekinPis statue which is only 55cm depicting a urinating little boy which is probably Brussels' most famous landmark & if you're lucky, MannekenPis will be wearing one of his 900 costumes.

• Free time for shopping for Worlds famous Belgium chocolates or you can saviorthe famous Belgium Waffel and French fries.

• Drive past St. Michael's Church

• Stop for a photograph at the Atomium which is the Icon of Belgium .The Atomium symbolizes an iron crystal, magnified 165 billion times

• Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan –Dinner)

DAY 05: Visit Mini-Europe a miniature park. Guided city tour Luxembourg.

• Visit Mini-Europe a miniature park that has reproductions of monuments in the European Union and other countries within the continent of Europe on display.

• Excursion by private coach to Luxembourg.

• Guided city tour of Luxembourg where you will see sights such as Place Guillaume II, Chemin de

la Corniche, Place d'Armes& Grand Ducal Palace.

• After an exciting day, return to Brussels back to hotel.

• Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan -Breakfast/Lunch /Dinner)

DAY 06: Day Excursion to the historic city of Ghent. Excursion to Bruges ("Venice of the

North.")Boat cruise to experience Bruges' picturesque canals.

•Excursion by private coach to the historic city of Ghent. During the walking tour, see St. Bavo's Cathedral, the gothic Cloth Hall & Belfry tower, Friday Market Square, Groot Kanonplein Square, and the streets of Graslei and Korenlei whose historic houses line Ghent's canals.

•Later travel by private coach to one of Belgium's best-loved cities, Bruges, the capital of West Flanders. The entire city center of this Dutch-speaking city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival to Bruges, meet a local guide who will lead your group on a walking tour of this especially beautiful city, which is often called the "Venice of the North."

•In addition to exploring its cobblestone streets and medieval quarters, the group will take a boat cruise to experience Bruges' picturesque canals.

•Free time for shopping and exploring the city on your own.

•After boarding the bus, return to the hotel in Brussels.

•Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan -Breakfast/Lunch /Dinner)

DAY 7: Arrive in Amsterdam

- Arrive in Amsterdam, the capital of the Netherlands.
- Proceed for an orientation tour of the city of Amsterdam by Canal cruise. This is undoubtedly the best way to appreciate this city of canals.
- Rest of the day is free to shop, wander alongside Amsterdam's canals, and to sample more of this country's cuisine.
- Overnight stay in Amsterdam (Meal Plan Dinner)

DAY 8 : Full-day excursion of windmills and tulips or miniature park. Along with visit to

Clog and Cheese making factory.

- The first stop today will be in Zaanse Schans, a neighborhood in the town of Zaandam, to admire its collection of historic windmills and its traditional craft shops.
- The group will then continue traveling south to the city of Lisse to tour the legendary Kuekenhof Gardens where vast numbers of tulips, daffodils, and hyacinths create dazzling patches of color. Blooms here – at their peak- have a short but glorious season. The park is said to be the greatest flower show on earth, and it's Holland's annual spring gift to the world or visit Madurodam, a miniature park and home to a range of perfect 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch monuments and projects
- Later we the old fashioned cheese-making farm. Witness a demonstration of how cheese is made. You also have a chance to savor some authentic Dutch cheese.
- Watch a shoemaker make clogs and wooden shoes carved out of wooden blocks.
- Overnight Stay in Amsterdam (Meal Plan- Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner).

DAY 9: Visit To Heineken Brewery, The Old Town harbor in Volendam & Visit to

picturesque town of Geithoorn.

- Group will undergo the Heineken Experience, a self-guided tour at its former brewery.
- Heineken Brewery is a Dutch brewing brand that produces one of the most famous lagers in the world.
- Visit to Volendam well known for its beautiful old harbor, fish trade & colourful timber houses
- Proceed your journey to **Geithoorn** a picturesque village which was **founded in the year 1230** by the Flagellants which is referred as "Venice of Netherland" Enjoy the peace and quiet of a town where cars are forbidden Admire the many types of boats in the town, from gondolas to punters and flat-bottom vessels used as transportation on the canals.
- Overnight Stay in Amsterdam (Meal Plan- Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)
