Day wise detailed Itinerary

Day 01 :Fly into Paris, the City of Lights and Glamour.

Welcome! Today we board our flight to one of the most beautiful cities - Paris. The fashionable and elegant city of Paris- known for its haute couture, renowned museums, breath-taking beautiful monuments and sensational cabarets.

- Upon arrival meet our local guide & we will proceed for guided city tour of Paris. See the Arc de Triomphe, the Champs-Elysees, Notre Dame, Invalides , Grand Palais, Petit Palais , Concord Square , Luxor obelisk , Alexander bridge, Madeleine church ,Opera house, Vendome Square the Louvre and the River Seine.
- Discover the charms of one of Paris' most popular neighborhoods on a walking tour of Montmartre, a district known for its artists and historically bohemian vibe. We will take a funicular ride up to Montmartre- Paris' tallest hill and enjoy the unmissable sights such as Sacré-Cœur Basilica and a view of the city from the top.
- Overnight stay in Paris.
- Meal Plan – Breakfast/ Lunch /Dinner.

DAY 02: Admission inside the Eiffel Tower (3rd Level) or the Montparnasse Tower . Enjoy Visit Versailles Palace and Seine River Cruise.

- During the tour your group will also ascend either the Eiffel Tower (3rd Level) or the Montparnasse Tower to appreciate the spectacular view of Paris in all her glory.
- Enhance your Paris sightseeing experience on a romantic Sightseeing cruise on the River Seine. Feel the love in the air as you drift along the river Seine on this romantic cruise. After embarking at the base of the Eiffel Tower, see the Cathedral of Notre Dame, Ile de la Cite, the rivers beautiful bridges, historical monuments, and many more Parisian Sights.
- Later, cruise along the romantic Seine river, and view some of the historical monuments by the river side .
- Overnight stay in Paris.
- Meal Plan – Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.

DAY 03: Fun at Euro Disney.

- Today Morning After continental Buffet Breakfast ,treat yourself to a magical time at Disneyland Paris.

- Overnight stay in Paris.

DAY 04: Arrival in Brussels, the capital of Belgium and headquarters of the European Union and NATO.

- Welcome!. Belgium As the capital of Belgium and the unofficial capital of the European Union, Brussels houses a remarkable mix of cultures. This is a city of contrasts. One district of Brussels is home to major European organizations and governing bodies like the European Commission, the European Parliament, NATO, and many others. However, it also contains a very historic city center and neighborhoods that have maintained traditional architecture and a slower pace. Its terrific mix of cultures, rich heritage, excellent museums, green parks, and exceptionally tasty food are just a few reasons to spend some time enjoying Brussels.
- We proceed for an Orientation tour of Brussels. During the tour group will visit one of Europe's most beautiful squares, the Grand Place, which is home to the medieval Town Hall.
- See Guild houses:- To differentiate them at first sight each house has a different symbol indicative of their job. Hence, we can see the wolf from the archers, the sack from the carpenters or the wheelbarrow from the milkmen. Moreover, if we continue our path through out the square we can notice a standing golden tree. It is one of the biggest and it represents the beer guild. Already in that time beer was really important for Belgium
- Town hall -: The Town Hall of the City of Brussels is a landmark building in Brussels At the top of the new tower, more than 90m high, the spire is crowned with the Archangel Saint-Michel, the patron saint of the City of Brussels. This gilded copper statue is actually used as a weather vane. If the winds blow the right way, you can admire the city's hero as he defeats the dragon!
- Maison di roi means the Kings House:- The new building retained the French name “Maison du Roi” that had been given to its predecessor, which was erected between 1515 and 1536. The original King’s House had in fact been built as an administrative complex at the request of Charles V, the Holy Roman Emperor who not only governed the Duchy of Brabant, of which Brussels was the capital city, but also a very extensive collection of territories including the Spanish kingdoms of Aragon and Castile.
- Photo stop at fabled Mannekin Piss statue.-: small yet one of the famous landmark of Brussels ,One tale maintains that the statue is a likeness of a boy who saved Brussels from fire and disaster by peeing on the fuse of an explosive; another story depicts the boy as the

victim of a witch's spell, frozen in time as punishment for peeing on her door. Whatever the case may be, the statue is likely here to stay.

- Free time for shopping for Belgium chocolates.
- You can taste world famous Belgium waffle and French fries.
- Drive past St. Michael's Church-: The Cathedral of St. Michael and St. Gudula is a medieval Roman Catholic cathedral in central Brussels, Belgium. It is dedicated to Saint Michael and Saint Gudula, the patron saints of the City of Brussels, and is considered to be one of the finest examples of Brabantine Gothic architecture.
- Stop for a photograph at the Atomium-:TheAtomium was constructed for the first post-war universal world exhibition (EXPO 1958), The nine spheres represent an iron crystal magnified 165 billion times. They represent the faith one had in the power of science and moreover in nuclear power.
- Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan –Breakfast/lunch/Dinner).

DAY 05: Day Excursion to the historic city of Ghent and Bruges ("Venice of the North.")

- Excursion by private coach to the historic city of Ghent. During the walking tour, see St. Bavo's Cathedral, the gothic Cloth Hall & Belfry tower, Friday Market Square, Groot Kanonplein Square, and the streets of Graslei and Korenlei whose historic houses line Ghent's canals.
- Later travel by private coach to one of Belgium's best-loved cities, Bruges, the capital of West Flanders. The entire city center of this Dutch-speaking city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Upon arrival to Bruges, meet a local guide who will lead your group on a walking tour of this especially beautiful city, which is often called the "Venice of the North."
- In addition to exploring its cobblestone streets and medieval quarters, the group will take a boat cruise to experience Bruges' picturesque canals.
- Free time for shopping and exploring the city on your own.
- After boarding the bus, return to the hotel in Brussels.
- Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan –Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner).

DAY 06: Visit Mini-Europe a miniature park. Day Excursion to Luxembourg.

- Excursion by private coach to Luxembourg.
- Guided tour of Luxembourg.
- After an exciting day, return to Brussels. The group will dine together in an Indian restaurant on its last evening in delightful Brussels.
- Visit Mini-Europe a miniature park that has reproductions of monuments in the European Union and other countries within the continent of Europe on display.
- Overnight stay in Brussels (Meal Plan –Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner).

DAY 07: Arrive in Amsterdam-Enjoy the Amsterdam Canal Cruise

- Today Morning we proceed for orientation tour of Amsterdam
- We proceed to Amsterdam to experience an exhilarating canal tour in your glass-topped boat as we drift through the canals.
- Thrive on the city's vibrant past with its 1,000 bridges and quaint old houses on your tour of Amsterdam.
- Overnight stay in Netherland.
- **Meal Plan** – Breakfast/lunch/Dinner.

DAY 08: Visit to Zaanse Schans. Visit to Keukenhof Gardens (15th May, 2022) or Visit to Madurodam (16th May onwards)

- Today Morning your group will depart on a full-day excursion of windmills and Tulip garden.
- The first stop today will be in Zaanse Schans, a neighbourhood in the town of Zaandam, to admire the indigenous look of Netherland village, where we see the collection of historic windmills and its traditional Wooden Shoe and Cheese Factory.
- Post lunch we proceed to city of Lisse to visit the legendary Keukenhof Gardens
- where vast numbers of Tulips, Daffodils and Hyacinths create dazzling patches of colour. Blooms here – at their peak- have a short but glorious season.
- The park is said to be the greatest flower show on earth, and it's Holland's annual spring gift to the world. *Keukenhof* gardens are open from **24 March until 15 May**.
- From **16th May** onwards, visit Madurodam, a miniature park and home to a range of perfect 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch monuments and projects, Photostop at International Court of Justice.
- Overnight stay in Netherland.
- **Meal Plan** – Breakfast /Lunch /Dinner.

DAY 09: Orientation tour of Amsterdam, Visit to Heineken Brewery, Highlight of tour Giethoon “Venice of Netherland”

- Today Morning we proceed our journey to 2 Beautiful city Amsterdam and Giethoon.
- Visit the **Heineken Brewery**. Where you can experience and see how the BEER is been made with barley and later have a chance to taste the Beer too at the end of the brewery tour.
- Visit **Giethoon** a picturesque, which is referred as “Venice of Netherland” here you will experience Boat ride
It is so peaceful, so different and has such simple beauty that it hardly seems real – gently gliding along small canals past old but pretty thatched-roof farmhouses.

- It is the Giethoorn village in Netherlands. It is too quiet, too serene and remote. It is so calm that its nickname of the “Dutch Venice” the water village of Giethoorn the loudest sound you can normally hear is the quacking of a duck or the noise made by other birds.
- Overnight stay in Netherlands (**Meal Plan** – Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner.)
