Day 03: Admission inside the Eiffel Tower (3rd Level) or the Montparnasse Tower. Later continue onward journey to Brussels, the capital of the European Union. Orientation tour and Photoshop at Atomium.

Today during the tour your group will also ascend either the Eiffel Tower (3rd Level) or the Montparnasse Tower to appreciate the spectacular view of Paris in all her glory. The Eiffel Tower—or as the French call it, La Tour Eiffel—is one of the world's most recognizable landmarks. This crown jewel of the Paris skyline and iconic symbol of France is at its most spectacular seen up close. See Paris from above and from a completely new perspective. Stroll through Grand-Place square, the heart of Belgium! or you will have Free time for shopping. Chocolate, beer, fries, waffles...Brussels has no shortage of delicious food and drinks

Next stop will be for a photograph at the Atomium which is the Icon of Belgium. The Atomium symbolizes an iron crystal, magnified 165 billion times. Get a taste of modern Brussels at the Atomium, built for the 1958 World.

The park is said to be the greatest flower show on earth, and it's Holland's annual spring gift to the world. After 15th May 2023 group will visit Madurodam, a miniature park and home to a range of perfect 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch monuments and projects.

Later we will Proceed for an orientation tour of the city of Amsterdam by Canal cruise. This is undoubtedly the best way to appreciate this city of canals. Amsterdam is as cute as it comes & sure to win your heart with its cobbled main streets, Canalside views & a café culture like no other. The cruise gives you a different take on one of Europe's hottest creative capitals!

We also included the visit to Volendam known as one of the most charming villages in all of Europe thanks to its narrow-cobbled streets lined with wooden houses and colourful flowers. You will also have chance to take photo of Traditional windmill.

Strasbourg is indeed one of Europe's most beautiful cities – from the imposing Cathedral with its intricate carvings, to the picturesque houses and canals of Petite France.



Day 05: Onward Journey towards Luxembourg as famous for being the second richest country in the world, being a European economic powerhouse. On Arrival City tour of Luxembourg city. Next stop is Strasbourg, capital of Christmas".

Today morning after the breakfast, we check out and proceed to Luxembourg, a landlocked country famed for its Roman heritage and architectural beauty. Luxembourg is famous for being the second richest country in the world, being a European economic powerhouse, and for having award-winning wines. Luxembourg is known for its capital city, also called Luxembourg, having a curious network of underground tunnels and for having three national languages. Embark on a comprehensive sightseeing tour of the city, visiting alluring landmarks like the Royal Palace of the Grand Duke, the 17th-century Notre-Dame Cathedral and many more sights. Later we will have opportunity to take photo at The Monument of Remembrance, usually known by the nickname of the Gëlle Fra (Golden Lady). Next, head to the modern side of the city to see prominent government buildings that play a pivotal role in the European Union. We then head to Strasbourg. Strasbourg Capital of Christmas famous for Christmas Market holds a place in the history books of Alsatian Christmases due to its longevity. First held in 1570, the famous "Christkindelsmärik" is considered to be the oldest Christmas market in France.

It's also the formal seat of the European Parliament and sits near the German border, with culture and architecture blending German and French influences. On arrival Enjoy the orientation tour of Strasbourg. See the magnificent city, Photo stop at the famous cathedral Notre dame de Strasbourg. Enjoy some leisurely free time exploring the charming Old Town.

Overnight stay in Strasbourg /Metz (Meal Plan – Breakfast/ Lunch /Dinner)

Day 06: Today drive to the Heart of Black Forest. Visit to Lake Titisee. Scenic drive towards Switzerland. On arrival, be awestruck at Europe's biggest and most stunning site- The Rhine Falls.

After you check out, relax in your coach as we drive to the heart of Black Forest known for its picturesque woods mostly consisting of pines and firs. Black Forest offers some of Europe's finest immersion in nature. The name Black Forest comes from the general dark colour of the numerous pine trees that grow in this region, and both the Black Forest gateau and cuckoo clock originate from this region. You will be enthralled at the scenic beauty of the quaint villages in the heart of black forest. Original German Cuckoo Clocks made in Black Forest. Black Forest wood carvers and clockmakers alike are considered to be the best in the world. Witness a demonstration of how cuckoo clocks are made. This the ideal place to pick up a few souvenirs from the local shops. Here you will also see the beautiful lake Titisee. It is the largest alpine lake in Germany with drinking water quality. On arrival group will avail some free time to explore the area independently or do shopping.

Next, sit back and relax in your coach while we drive towards scenic Switzerland. With magical views unfolding outside our windows we'll find ourselves in Switzerland. We will Stop at Schaffhausen where you will see the magnificent Rhine Falls - Europe's biggest and most stunning site. Take tons of selfies in front of this amazing natural phenomenon, then continue on your way. You are now completely surrounded by nature's beauty. Literally, you can turn in any direction and you will see snow-capped peaks, clear-blue lakes and scenic beauty. Breathe in the fresh air and enjoy your time in this idyllic place.

Day 07: Highlight of the tour, A magical alpine excursion to the top of Europe - the amazing Jungfraujoch and visit to scenic Interlaken.

After breakfast we drive to Interlaken, a unique and fascinating scenic city situated between two lakes, Thun and Brienz for an orientation tour of Interlaken. This town is very famous for Bollywood and Hollywood movies. On arrival you will have free time to explore the beautiful town of Switzerland.

Later we proceed to Experience a highlight of European travel when you journey to Jungfraujoch - Top of Europe! Board the new state-of-the-art Eiger Express aerial cableway to the Eiger Glacier. Take the cogwheel train to Jungfraujoch, Europe's highest railway station at 3,454 mtr (11,333 feet). The final stretch of the train-ride takes you literally through the mountain, and, when you emerge, the view from the top is spectacular - provided it's a clear day, of course! At this height, there's year-round snow, so you'll be able to have snow-ball fights and build snowmen even in the height of summer. Marvel at the longest glacier of the Alps, listed as a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Visit the Ice Palace where artists create their work of art in ice. Visit the Sphinx observatory deck to experience a breath-taking panoramic view of the longest glacier in the Alps - Aletsch Glacier. This is one part of the journey that is definitely not to be missed!

Overnight stay in Switzerland (Meal Plan – Breakfast/ Lunch /Dinner)

Day 08: Visit to Mt Titlis, Orientation tour of Lucerne with Visit to Lion Monument and Kappel bruke bridge. Free time for shopping.

Today enjoy amazing scenery, a once in a lifetime experience with an exhilarating trip to the top of Mt Titlis. At 3020 meters (10000 ft) above the sea level, TITLIS is the jewel in Central Switzerland's crown and the only publicly accessible glacier in the area. You will feel on top of the world as you take in the spectacular panoramic views of snow-covered mountains and unspoilt Alpine landscapes. The journey to the Titlis is truly an adventure in itself. First take the TITLIS Xpress gondola to the middle station, then continue your journey in the TITLIS Rotair, the world's first revolving cable car, all the way to the top. Get a breath taking unrestricted 360 degrees stunning view of the dazzling snow caped peak, deep crevasses and pristine white snow fields, dotted with massive ice boulders from every angle. Do not forget to visit the "Cliff Walk" the highest suspension bridge in Europe along the cliff of Mt Titlis. Later we proceed to Lucerne. famous for its wooden bridges, cobbled lanes and beautiful setting against the lake it's named after. Here we'll visit Lion monument, a giant dying lion carved out of a wall of sandstone rock, which commemorates the Swiss Guards who were massacred in 1792 during the French Revolution. later we'll visit Kappelbrucke Wooden Bridge - World's oldest covered wooden bridge spanning the River Reuss. Later Free time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives, souvenirs and chocolates. Spend the evening exploring!

Day 09: Orientation tour of Vaduz. Drive to Innsbruck, Visit Swarovski Crystal Museum – the dazzling world of crystals.

Today our first stop is the Alpine principality of Liechtenstein, the sixth-smallest country in the world. Stopping in the Vaduz, is the peaceful capital of Liechtenstein, which is landlocked by its two wealthy neighbors, Switzerland and Austria. Discover Vaduz during a short but sweet orientation tour, in which you will learn the most interesting facts about the city, the local lifestyle and the modern transformation of the city. During the tour we will visit Peter-Kaiser-Platz (Pass By)-The Liechtenstein State Square, where the government building is located and immediately after that the 2007 newly created parliament building. Later you will have free time to explore and feel spellbound in a charming atmosphere.

Later we proceed for an orientation tour Innsbruck one of the beautiful cities of Austria. Begin your exploration at Herzog Friedrich Street in the Centre of Innsbruck. Admire Innsbruck's famous shining landmark, the Golden Roof. It is considered the city's most famous symbol. Completed in 1500, the roof was decorated with 2,657 fire-gilded copper tiles for Emperor Maximilian I to mark his wedding to Bianca Maria Sforza. Later walk down cobblestone pathways of Maria Theresien Stresses and live though the medieval European culture. A delight to explore, the neighborhood is a collection of cobblestone streets, boutiques, medieval buildings, and sidewalk cafes.

In the evening we will proceed to Wattens to discover the home of Swarovski: where you will visit the Swarovski Crystal Worlds - one of the most visited attractions in Austria. The Swarovski Crystal Worlds in Wattens, Tyrol, weaves a spell around every visitor: a water-spouting giant that magically lures the beholder into a hidden world, where Chambers of Wonder fire up the imagination. His face has become a globally-recognized icon and the attraction has seen more than 12 million visitors pass through its doors. During the visit you explore 16 Chambers of Wonder to see works of many artists, designers, and architects who interpreted crystals in their own unique ways and experience the magic of crystal in a dimension that has never been seen before. A great opportunity to buy a souvenir for your family.

Overnight Stay Tyrol Region (Meal Plan – Breakfast/ Lunch/ Dinner)



Day 10: Romantic Venice – Sprawling squares, beautiful monuments, serpentine canals and mysterious alleyways – a lagoon city that inspired poetry and passion through the ages. A glassblowing demonstration. Treasure a romantic Gondola ride too.

Buongiorno! Venice is ours for a full and glorious Italian day. This morning, check out of your hotel and proceed towards Italy. Arrive at the pier where we board a private boat. Sail over the Giudecca Canal, past the Adriatic Sea to arrive at St. Mark's Square – the main square of Venice. On arrival View St Mark's Basilica – one of the best examples of Byzantine architecture, Witness the famed Bell Tower and Clock Tower with the dominant sign of the Zodiac and current phase of the moon. See the Bridge of Sighs, made of white lime stone, that passes over the Rio di Palazzo, connecting the old prisons with interrogations rooms at the Doge's Palace. Witness a Murano Glass demonstration and marvel at the intricate and colorful glass artefacts, hand-crafted by master craftsmen. Treasure a romantic Gondola ride in a flat-bottomed Venetian rowing boat, amidst the stunning backdrop of baroque buildings. Sit back & watch the city open up from the canals in a gondola. From magnificent palazzi looming in the distance to the locals' laundry strung across the backwaters, Venice's charm gets you at every turn. This truly is the best way to enjoy this enchanting city. We return to the pier by private Boat and later check in to your hotel.

Overnight Stay Padova. (Meal Plan – Breakfast/Lunch/ Dinner)

Day 11: Visit the remarkable and famous Leaning Tower of Pisa.

All roads lead to Rome – the eternal city.

This morning after check out and we drive towards Tuscany Region. On arrival at Pisa Parking and proceed to the Square of Miracles and see the remarkable Leaning Tower of Pisa. The Field of Miracles (This piazza is called II Campo dei Miracoli in Italia) is the most popular attraction in Pisa and one of the most famous places in the world. This walled 8.87-hectare area (22 acres) consists of The Leaning Tower, the Duomo, the Baptistry, and the Monumental Cemetery. Here's your chance to perfect the holding-up-the-tower shot, so make it a good one. Capture your iconic shots at the Leaning Tower of Pisa! A World Heritage UNESCO Site, The Leaning Tower is visited by tourists from every corner of the globe and is one of the most popular cultural European landmarks.

Overnight stay in Tuscany. (Meal Plan – Breakfast/Lunch/ Dinner)



Day 12: Guided city tour of Rome. Enter the world's smallest country – the Vatican City. Photo stop at Colosseum, a vast Amphitheatre. Visit the beautiful Trevi Fountains.

Today we proceed towards the eternal city of Rome, a city built on seven hills situated on the banks of the river Tiber. It is the most visited city in Italy and third most populous city in the European Union. Rome is full of secrets and has a very long history that spans millennia, and its attraction only seems to increase with each passing year. On arrival proceed for a guided city tour of Rome with an expert English-speaking local guide. Arrive at the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world (shorts or sleeveless vests not allowed). Explore the historical treasures of the Vatican City, inside its Museums & the Sistine Chapel. Admire the wonders of this most impressive collection, with the highpoint being Michelangelo's Renaissance masterpieces 'The Creation' & 'The Last Judgement'. Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapple & the divinely beautiful basilica of St. Peter's – the unparalleled home of architectural and artistic masterpieces. Get mesmerized by the works of Michelangelo and Bernini. Religious or not, the Vatican's Italian Renaissance church will send shivers down your spine. Later we continue and drive past the Victor Emmanuel Monument, the Roman Forum, and several more sights of this remarkable city of Rome. You will get opportunity to get Photo at Colosseum, a vast amphitheater. Visit the beautiful Trevi Fountain, where the legend goes that tossing a coin over your shoulder gets you back to Rome
