- Be respectful of the garden, other gardeners, the Old Sauk Community Garden Committee, the surrounding woods and prairie and the surrounding neighborhood.
- Adhere to the Old Sauk Community Garden Rules and Expectations.
- Plant, care for and maintain my plot in accordance with the Old Sauk Community Garden Rules and Expectations. Use organic weed and insect control practices (no weed killers such as Roundup or pesticides such as Sevin or other broad spectrum insecticides).
- Keep my plot and the path around it weeded and tended. Plots will be monitored by garden committee members every month for compliance. Untended plots will receive three notices. If the plot remains untended beyond the final notice, the garden committee reserve the right to not allow you to garden at Old Sauk in the future.
- Participate in at least two work days; work includes path maintenance, weed management, tool repairs, composting, etc.
- Follow land use, parking rules and other program requirements.
- Clear my plot at the end of the gardening season. All plots must be cleared by: **October 26th.**

WORK DAYS

Work days are necessary for the success of the garden. Check either **Opening or Closing** and at least one other day from the list below when you can help with common tasks. Reminders will be e-mailed and attendance tracked.

Opening Day, Saturday, May 4th, 9:00 AM.

Lay out plots, set up sites, put in name stakes, distribute hay and compost.
Remove and clean tools from the shed.

Closing Day, Saturday, October 26th, 9:00 AM.

Remove site markers, name stakes and return/clean all tools and hoses to the shed.

Pre Opening Day, Saturday, April 27th, 9:00 AM.

Clean garden, prepare for tilling, cut cardboard for walking paths.





WORK DAYS (Continued)

- Early Summer Work Day, Saturday, June 22nd, 9:00 AM.** Projects as needed.
- Mid Summer Work Day, Saturday, July 20th 9:00 AM.**
Weed common areas and other work projects as needed.
- Late Summer Work Day, Saturday, August 24th, 9:00 AM.**
Weed common areas and other work projects as needed.

- Phone and Email:** All Old Sauk Community Gardeners must share their phone numbers with the volunteer coordinators at their garden. Some gardens also circulate a public phone list. PAYMENT FOR YOUR GARDEN PLOT AND BALES OF HAY

The fee for a full plot at Old Sauk Community Garden is \$50.00. A full plot is approximately 400 square feet. New gardeners are encouraged to request a half plot for half the fee (\$25.00). The maximum any gardener can request is 1 full plot. If it is difficult, or you are unable to pay for your plot, please contact oldsaukgardens@gmail.com and we can waive plot fees when warranted.
