Five Indigenous female recruits who competed in the Parks to Clubs Summer 6's trial were selected by Aspire Hockey Cairns to travel to Perth, taking part in the Hockey Australia Pro League Indigenous Round March 2020. These young women achieved and exceeded their targets for 95% school attendance, and worked together to complete the Healthy Habits - Healthy Body, Healthy Mind program. This program highlights the benefits of making strong choices and personal well-being and through these challenges, empowerment and leadership skills were developed and supported.
