



In this portion of the conference, Scott shares testimony and stories from his life. As you probably know, he was born with a bone disease called osteogenesis imperfecta that causes the bones to break easily. Scott had his first broken bone when he was 3 weeks old. Throughout his childhood, he would have estimated 200 broken bones. The doctors gave him little hope of having a "normal" life, in fact many doubted he would live passed the age of 12 years old. If he did live, the bone disease is suppose to get worse as you get older, however God had other plans... Scott was saved at the age of 12 and has not had a broken bone since that day. Through the brokenness that he has endured in his life, Scott has gained blessings to share with others. Music came into his life when he was 6 years old when he was given a toy piano. That piano became his best friend. Even though he couldn't play sports and do the things

other kids were doing outside, Scott had his piano. The music that comforted him as a child has followed him throughout his life, and has given him platforms to share the Love of Jesus across America; even in Branson Missouri, winning Keyboard player of the year for 2021. Not only did God give Scott music, but He also gave him laughter. From the earliest times of his life, stories from his parents, nurses, doctors, etc. talk about Scott's upbeat attitude and how he made them laugh. That jovial spirit has followed him throughout his life. That humor definitely comes out in Scott's presentation of The Gospel.

Although physical brokenness has always been a major part of Scott's testimony, through situations that have happened, even in the past few years, he has endured emotional brokenness. Just as he has tried to use the trials from the bone disease to minister to people, he desires to take the situations that he has been through to help men that may have gone through or are going through similar things.

The ladies will stay with Lori Anne for **The Broken Enough Women's Conference**. She has put together this amazing conference to encourage ladies who have been or are currently living in a state of brokenness. Through her testimony and truths that God has shown her through His Word, she presents the message in a transparent and touching way. Lori Anne's testimony is of emotional healing. She grew up in an

emotionally abusive home. Though her mom had her in church every time the doors were open, and even sang in other churches as she was soloist, her dad wasn't a Christian, and wanted no part of Jesus. Lori Anne gave her heart to the Lord when she was very young. Jesus was a place of comfort for her during the hardest times of life. Lori Anne's Dad and Mom divorced when she was a teenager, and she dreaded the times she had to spend the weekend with him. Lori Anne has always had a love for music, and when she was young, she started singing with her mom. Not long after she started singing specials in church, she was sitting at the kitchen table, singing a song, not really thinking about what she was doing. Her dad recorded her singing on a voice recorder. He instantly played it back, saying, "do you think anyone wants to hear that? Do you think anyone wants to hear you sing?" "No one wants to hear you sing," Those words hurt and left scars that will not heal. Through brokenness from this and many other things, God uses Lori Anne's testimony to minister to people that have experienced some of those same types of struggles.

In this well thought out and Spirit led conference Lori Anne combines Scripture along with many trials that she has endured even in her adult life to help ladies that are going through tough times. She takes the words "Broken Enough" to bring out that you have to be broken to a certain degree for God to be able to use you, but there comes a time when you have to say, "Enough with being broken" and allow the healing balm of The Holy Spirit to put those broken pieces back together.

In both Scott's and Lori Anne's presentations, they bring out that the scars may still be there, but God can use those scars and broken places to shine His light through to lead someone else to Jesus.



To complete the day, Scott and Lori Anne bring everyone back together. They will again open with music. Both praise and worship and Southern Gospel style worship. They lead this portion of the conference together. Among other things, they tell stories from the road and things that God has done through and for this ministry.

It is their desire to “Recharge” those that attend this conference to move forward in their lives and the ministry of the church.

What is the format of the Recharge Conference?

In other conferences that we have held, the church provided lunch. It worked out really well. If you would like to do that, what we would do would be to start out together then separate into the men and women’s conferences. We would then meet together to have lunch, then finish with the ending session together.

In a recent conference, Scott led the **God Uses Broken Vessels Men’s Conference** on Friday night and Lori led the **Broken Enough Women’s Conference** on Saturday. In this format, the ending session doesn’t work as well for the two coming together, however it can work.

Is there a set fee to bring The Recharge Conference to my church?

There is no set fee. Everything that Even You Ministries does, we do on a free will offering. As you know, it does take money to live and travel. 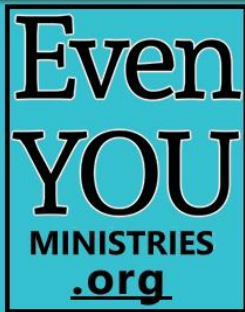
