Dr. Carol Ann Barry will be helping us discover the art of harmonic and creative outlining. Based on the approach of pedagogue Abby Whiteside, finding emotional rhythm of a piece helps students focus on the musical aspects of practice, encouraging more favorable results.

Dr. Barry holds degrees from Old Dominion University, the University of Louisville, and a DMA from James Madison University. A Rotary Fellow, she studied at the Goethe institute and the Hochschule fur Musik in Hamburg, Germany. Her major teachers have included Lee Luvisi, Dr. Eric Ruple, Brian Ganz, Dr. James Litzelman, and Sophia Rosoff.

She is the recipient of both the 2010 PTG Grant and the MTNA Foundation Teachers Grant. She is currently writing a book documenting pianist Sophia Rosoff's teaching career based on the principles of Abby Whiteside. Rosoff's codification of Whiteside's teaching approach was the topic of her doctoral research project. Dr. Barry has presented numerous lectures and pedagogy workshops and is passionate about the field of piano pedagogy. Her private studio is located in Cary, NC, and she is a collaborative pianist for the vocal department at University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. In 2017, Dr. Barry founded Piano Pedagogues Key International, an educational piano pedagogy video and teaching materials company.

VMTA THEORY NOTICE

Hello Music Teachers,

This is a reminder that on Saturday, January 26, 2019, the Tidewater Music Teachers Forum (TMTF) will administer the VMTA Theory Test. This Event will be held at the Student Webb Center at Old Dominion University, Norfolk, Virginia. The Registration Deadline is Saturday, January 5, 2019.

Levels 4 - 12 begin at 9:00 a.m.

Levels Pri - 3B begin at 10:30 a.m.

I encourage everyone to participate. Teachers who are not members of TMTF can also participate. Contact Marilyn Forman, TMTF Theory Chair, if you are a non-member and interested to participate.

The phone number and email address for Marilyn Forman is at the bottom of this page.

The Registration Form and the Student Release Form are in the TMTF Activity Book.

Please make copies of the *Student Release Form*, which is found in the TMTF Activity Book, for your students. Please note that each student should have their own form. Do not combine siblings on one form. Have your students bring this form with them on the day of the Theory Test. Also, please help them fillout the form. Do not mail your *Student Release Forms* to the Theory Chairman. Along with the *Student Release Form*, please also have your students bring two pencils for their use.



Students can take only one test per year. The fee is \$14.00 for one test. Mail the Registration Form, and also include one check reflecting the sum of the students entered and payable to TMTF. Do not have students mail their registration to the Theory Chairman. Only the teachers should mail the Registration form and the one check totaling the registration sum amount of the students entered to the TMTF Theory Chairman, Marilyn Forman. This also applies to a teacher entering one student. The teacher should mail the Registration form and check.

Reminders:

- ◆Students may enter the program at any level or skip levels at the discretion of their teacher.
- ◆Students who previously failed a test can go to the next level provided the private teacher tests and approves the student to proceed.
- ◆An oral test can be given if requested on the Registration Form.
- ◆The knowledge required for the Theory Test is cumulative, and may include questions based on materials required from previous levels. There are no retakes for failures in the same year, and there are no make-up dates for the Theory Test should students be absent on the Theory Test day. Students who are absent the day of the Theory Test will receive their test but not receive VMTA credit for the test.
