GLOVER SCHOLARSHIP AUDITIONS

The Glover Scholarship Auditions were held April 6th, 2019 at Monumental United Methodist Church in Portsmouth. We had twelve teachers enter students this year. Fifty six students were registered and fifty auditioned. Twenty six students won a monetary award within grades 5 through 8. These awards included a first place (\$400), second place (\$350), third place (\$300) and honorable mention (\$250) award in each grade. Each grade had more than one honorable mention award winner.
