GLOVER SCHOLARSHIP AUDITIONS

The Glover Scholarship Auditions were held on April 22, 2023 at Monumental United Methodist Church in Portsmouth. We had eight teachers enter students in the event this year. NEW SCHOLARSHIP PARTICIPATION POLICY:

Money raised from the TMTF Play-A-Thon supports all three scholarships TMTF offers: Louise Garrow Scholarship, David Carr Glover Scholarship and Glen Mayberry Scholarship. Therefore, eligibility for students to receive funds requires that the teachers' studios must participate in the Play-A-Thon (at least one student must represent the studio) for the current school year. Thus far, we have had this policy in place for David Carr Glover and Glen Mayberry Scholarships; starting in 2024, this policy will also take effect for the Louise Garrow Scholarship. (A TMTF teacher's studio must participate in the 2023 December Play-A-Thon in order for their 2024 Eastern District Audition Winners, who are traveling to the 2024 State Competitions, to receive the Louise Garrow Scholarship).


