Important MTNA Competitions Information for 2020!

Hello, Everyone --

I hope you're staying well, safe, and in good spirits as we continue to navigate our way through these still uncertain days. VMTA is currently working to adapt our events as needed for the upcoming year to transition to online events as needed; please be on the lookout for detailed information about all our events for 2020 - 2021 within the next few weeks. In the meantime, the deadline for the MTNA Competitions in Virginia will be held ONLINE this year. Our state competitions chair, Dr. Lise Keiter, and I have been in numerous conversations with Linda Stump, MTNA National Competitions Coordinator, to transition the competitions from live events to online competitions for this year. Virtually all the states are going digital this year; MTNA has developed detailed information and procedures for this that will be communicated should you register students.

Meanwhile, what you need to know now about the MTNA competitions -- from Dr. Keiter:

Due to Covid-19, the 2020 MTNA Competitions will be by Video Only. There will not be a live competition this year at the State Level in Virginia.

The Application process is in two steps:

- Complete your Application ONLINE on the MTNA Website HERE.
 The Application Deadline is Sep. 16, 2020 at 3 pm ET.
 Do not send videos with your application. That is a separate process.
- You will send in your video separately. You will not be submitting your video to the MTNA Website.

The Video Deadline is October 19, 2020.

Complete instructions for Video Submissions will be sent out in early September (Note that we are not ready to accept videos yet). Please wait for further instructions.

If you have any questions in the meantime, please contact Dr. Lise Keiter, MTNA State Competitions Chair for Virginia at **LKeiter@marybaldwin.edu**.

Important: If you intend to enter the MTNA Competitions and plan to send a video, you must first submit your application (by Sep. 16).

Once again, please direct your questions about the MTNA competitions to Dr. Lise Keiter (**LKeiter@marybaldwin.edu**); if you ask me, I will have to relay your question to her anyway and a response may be delayed.

As always, please stay safe, stay well, and all the best for the upcoming academic year.




A GUIDE TO MASK USE



Before putting on a mask, clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.



Cover mouth and nose with mask and make sure there are no gaps between your face and the mask.



Replace the mask with a new one as soon as it is damp and do not re-use single-use masks.



To remove the mask: remove it from behind (do not touch the front of mask); discard immediately in a closed bin; clean hands with alcohol-based hand rub or soap and water.
