The Janet S. Phelps Music Education Scholarship application is now active with at May 15, 2025 deadline.

Information on the scholarship is as follows:

Purpose:

This scholarship is in honor of the dedication and leadership of Janet S. Phelps of the Music Ministry at King's Grant Presbyterian Church. The Scholarship is established to encourage men and women to prepare for and/or continue with music-related vocation and/or to further education opportunities for students of music performance, teaching, and related music expenses.

Award:

- Up to five (5) scholarship may be awarded.
- The minimum amount of an individual scholarship is \$1,000.00.
- The scholarships awarded shall be applied to the tuition expense of a college, university, or other accredited institutions of higher learning, or applied to other related expenses.

Eligibility:

- Applicants shall be either:
- Current and former members of Kings Grant Presbyterian Church and their immediate family (children and grandchildren)
- City of Virginia Beach Resident
- Current and former students of the Virginia's Governor's School for the Arts
