- Fourth and fifth graders have been invited to apply for student leadership roles, and we hope to make selections and get more students assisting with jobs around the school in the coming weeks. Third graders will be invited to apply for leadership roles after winter break. Student leaders could be asked to help with PTO events throughout the year.
- Big thank you to the PTO for the breakfast and treats provided during our pre-service days. These were greatly appreciated as we prepared for the start of the school year.

- We had our staff introduction assembly the Friday before Labor Day.
- School Improvement Advisory Committee representatives needed- Beaver Creek has been asked to identify two parents to serve on the SIAC committees. One committee focuses on Academics/Postsecondary pathways for students. The other committee focuses on SEBMH needs and supports for students. These meetings take no more than four times per year and meet from 6:30-8:00 pm at the district office.
