- May 2023 Meeting Minutes
- Motion to approve meeting minutes as presented Brooke Whiting; second Eliza Dy-Boarman. Motion passes.
- <u>Review new proposed By-Laws</u>. Main updates 1) no longer requiring PTO members to pay PTO dues, 2) members can serve more than two years in an executive position if there isn't anyone else who wants the position. Most other updates to streamline.
 - Will vote to approve at the September meeting.

Treasurer's Report – Cory Root

- Not a lot of new items over the summer, just student folders and laminating. The folders will be simple folders this year as pricing for the Dragon folders went up dramatically.
- Will continue to fund 'Back to school' grants to give \$\$ to every new teacher to the building as well as teachers switching grades. Spend \$450.
- Grade level Leader In Me t-shirt difference will be covered by PTO.
- Will continue use of Venmo QR code at all events to make donations and PTO payments for things easier. There is a small fee for using Venmo but worth it in increased donations.

Committee Reports

- Fundraising Fun Run Rachel Miller / Jenni Gruenisen
 - Fundraising kickoff 10/6 or 9/30 (whichever aligns with the school assembly)
 - Fun Run will wrap-up the Fundraiser on 10/20
 - Similar format to last year just no birthday party. The gist is "Donate what you can & then we have a fun-run".
 - One fundraiser packet sent home per family; along with QR codes to the Venmo account.
 - Each grade will be at a set time and will run as many laps as they can during the time.
 - There will be bananas, water, and kids will wear their BC shirts.
 - Fundraising goal for 2023/2024 and 2024/2025 will be to enhance the playground. Mr. Toot is working with some partners to get options and potential costs. Hopefully we'll be able to do some/half next summer and then the rest the summer after.
 - Ideas include: adjustable basketball hoops, Gaga ball pit, more accessible area (maybe to cover up the wet/soggy area), paint/refresh current items, a few new items, etc.
 - Will not be a whole new playground just a 'refresh'
 - Same fundraiser framework as last year steps with certain \$ amounts to earn the kids rewards.
 - Let Jenni or Rachel know if you can help with any portion / beforehand / or day of. Will also send out sign-up sheets for volunteers.

- Restaurant Nights Eliza Dy Boarman
 - Usually one per month, the amount brought in varies. Will likely repeat some easy/high earners from last year and try out some new ones.

 - Working on others Pagliai's, Culvers, maybe not Orange Leaf, Chick Fil A. Some other ideas were floated by others.
