Courtyard Project Update - Matthew Mikles

- purpose: provide outdoor learning space with attractive courtyard and have long term solutions with low maintenance
- plan includes:
- sod for plush grass - seed has been done before and doesn't seem to work
- edged perimeter w/pea gravel, landscaping fabric, maybe low maintenance plants
- 5 concrete slabs (measuring $8 \times 8 \times 4$ ") including an accessible pad for wheelchairs, use tables from gazebo or combine funds to buy uniform tables
- estimated costs: sod $\$ 700$, rock $\$ 1664$, ground cloth $\$ 60$, edging $\$ 144$, concrete $\$ 777.50$ (could be as high as $\$ 1500$ ); ball park total: $\$ 3345.50$
- diagram (photo included below): orange is rock perimeter, green is concrete slabs, wheelchair path at bottom right with accessible table. blue area stays wet/muddy so we can fill with pea gravel and maybe add colorful chairs
- could have around 30 seating options with the right tables, enough for a full class
- Timeline: may be ambitious, but hoping to finish by June 1! We will break ground in May, do work during evenings and weekends.
- If anyone has contacts for sod, concrete and/or rock, please share
- Mr Toot will check into money handling. Usually the PTO writes a check to BC who then makes the purchases (tax free). Matthew will get final approval from scouts.


## Principal's Report - Mr. Toot

- This is the busy time of year, with 35 days of school left. It is great to see the progress that students have made and how independent they have become. The rest of the year will fly by. We are planning on the last student day for Thursday, June 1 with a three hour early out
- Our fifth graders had a great time at Junior Achievement Biz Town last Thursday. This is always one of the highlights of fifth grade. They apply for jobs, learn about the community, elect and mayor and a DA. We have lots of parent volunteers.
- We are finishing up make up tests for the lowa Statewide Assessment of Student Progress (ISASP) testing week for 3rd, 4th and 5th graders. The testing has gone well, and we look forward to seeing the results in the next few weeks.
- All students will do their final literacy and math screening assessments in early May. There has been strong growth, especially in our literacy screening results this year, and we have done some goal setting around our literacy data.
