Principal's Report – Mr. Toot

- Today was day 57 of the school year and conferences are behind us. Huge thanks for the conference dinners! We had great attendance at fall conferences. It was great to see all of the items donated to the “free to take” table, and a number of items were taken by families during the conference nights. We will keep some of the items at Beaver Creek for students who have some needs, and the rest will be donated to the Johnston Partnership.
- The Beaver Creek PTO Run/Walk event was a big success! We had a beautiful day and a great turn out. Thanks to the PTO for organizing the event and helping arrange for volunteers and snacks for all of the participants.

- Our first concerts of the year will be held on Thursday, November 20, with the fourth and fifth grade concerts. There will be a school wide assembly the morning of Friday, November 21, and our fourth and fifth graders will be performing a few of their concert songs at that assembly.
- Safety Drills: A lock down drill was practiced last month. This is one of many safety drills we practice each year.
- Second and Third grade students will be going to a performance of the Nutcracker on Friday, December 12, at the Des Moines Civic Center. In future years, this will transition to a second grade field trip, as third grade students get an Opera Iowa experience provided by the Vocal Parents Association.
- Winter parties and winter break: Tentative plans are for classroom winter parties to be held on Friday, December 19. Our winter assembly will take place prior to the classroom parties. I will be asking teachers/grade levels what type of support they will need from families-volunteers to assist with the planning and party, donations from families.
- An iPad refresh will take place in December. A decision was made to replace our iPads with the newest generation, and the school district is saving money by doing so. One change is the new iPads will not have a traditional headphone jack, but instead headphones will need a USB C connector or converter. We will have converters available, but a family is welcome to purchase headphones with a USB C connector for their child. We do not want students bringing airpods or wireless headphones to school.
