



Honoring Family and Church

Gary L. Burgess, Sr., is a native of Inman, South Carolina. He gives God the praise and honor for allowing him to serve HIS CHURCH, his family, his community, his state and his nation in various capacities. He understands clearly that if it had not been for God's providence he would be lost. Pastor Burgess' boast is only in Jesus Christ because he is a redeemed

man, a Christian, having no merit of himself or within himself, who has been put in right position with God through the shed blood and resurrection power of Our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ.

Pastor Burgess is a recipient of the Spartanburg County Jaycee's Young Religious Leader Award. He addressed an interdenominational faith youth group on the Lewis Islands in Stornoway, Scotland. Pastor Burgess understands that God has a "future and a hope" for his people, and him, as Jeremiah proclaimed (Jeremiah 29:11). She was the second woman in the 165 year history of the college to win a Southern Conference Championship. She currently resides in Charlotte, North Carolina and is involved in the financial sector. Dr. Burgess' god-daughter, a gifted academician, Joycelyn Hardy, MD, is a Summa Cuma Lauda graduate (the highest academic honor a University awards) of Clemson University, and a graduate of MUSC, the Medical University of South Carolina, Charleston.
