
There are two simple steps you can take that will make the biggest difference.

- 1) Invest in fuel-efficient hybrids, plug-in hybrids or full electric vehicles. You might believe these cars would be too expensive, but you would be mistaken. They are cheaper to fuel and maintain. Factoring in significantly reduced fuel costs and much lower maintenance expenses, and adding in state and federal tax credits (for now) you can begin to see how much you'll save over the lifetime of a hybrid or electric vehicle. - 2) Switch to 100% clean renewable electricity in your home. Next to purchasing a fuel-efficient vehicle, switching to a clean electricity provider is the next best thing you can do to lower your greenhouse gas emissions.
