



Daycon Issues Updated 43-101 for Snowstorm, and Confirms Water Right

Toronto, Ontario – January 6, 2020 – **Daycon Minerals Corporation** (“**Daycon**” or “**the Company**”), the holder of the Snowstorm Project in Idaho, which includes the past producing Snowstorm Mine, has issued an updated Technical Report on the Snowstorm Copper-Silver Project, Shoshone County, Idaho dated July 18, 2019.

Authored by Skip Yates, CPG and QP, the Report considers a two part plan of exploration; a two-year program of core drilling for ore to further Daycon’s new discovery of mineralization at depth in the previously unexplored Lower Revett at the property, together with IP/Resistivity and Magnetic surveys for the faulted off high grade ore shoot that was the site of historic production (800,000 tons of ore containing 4% Cu, 6 opt Ag and 0.1 opt Au 1903-1925).

Daycon also announces that it has confirmed and registered ownership of Idaho Water Right 94-2064 which allows for the taking of 1 cubic foot per second (over 26,900 gallons per hour) from the Gentle Annie Gulch Creek with the point of diversion on Daycon’s claims.
