the sun shines." I have often thought about that statement and believe that it is as true today as it was 50 years ago. Jesus said in John 9:4, "I must work the works of him that sent me, while it is day: the night cometh, when no man can work." A recent example of not working while it is day, occurred in the fall of 1939 and went into the spring of 1940. Germany had attacked Poland and England and France had declared war on Germany. France, with a larger army than that of Germany at that time, sat behind what they thought was the safety of the Maginot Line. This was a fortress that stretched from Switzerland to the Ardennes Forest. The fortress they believed was impenetrable, and the forest impassable. If the French had attacked Germany in the fall of 1939, Germany could have been defeated, and over six million Jews would have not perished in the Holocaust. A MissionInsite report I received today stated that church inactivity of the residents of Jefferson County grew from 61.46 % in 2017 to 73.24 % in 2021. The Bible reminds us that Satan is our adversary, and he goes around as a roaring lion seeing who he may devour. So, as my grandfather said, "We need to make hay while the sun shines."

It will begin with personal outreach. This includes door to door personal soulwinning. The Billy Graham Evangelistic Association says that personal invitations from family, friends and neighbors is the most effective way of sharing Jesus. I want to encourage everyone to pray and then speak to their lost family, friends, and neighbors. Many of our churches have weekly outreach, and I encourage you to get involved. If you do not presently have a weekly outreach, I would love to help you get one started.

Another great outreach is our Good News Clubs. Most will be starting back soon, and we still need a few more volunteers. We will have a Good News Club volunteer training at Talbott Baptist Church on Saturday, September 13 beginning at 8:30 A.M. and ending at 2:30 P.M. Danny Newman at 865-604-4990. These are just some of the opportunities we have to reach our lost neighbors, and we must by all means we must reach them.
