August brings us to a new school year, and with it another year sharing Christ to the children of Jefferson County through our Good News Clubs. Please be in prayer for all of our volunteers and the children we will have the privilege of ministering to.

We have been blessed this summer with our Vacation Bible Schools in our various communities. We began in Reidtown with the help of five churches and saw 8 children make professions of faith. Several weeks later our second VBS was at Centennial Park in Jefferson City. We had three of our churches helping and saw two more children trust Christ as their Savior. That was followed up by one day Bible Schools at Talbott, Buffalo Grove and Mansfield Gap. Last week we saw 1 child saved at our Bible School which was held at Jefferson Elementary School's playground on Monday and Tuesday, but at the associational office last Wednesday because of the rain. I would like to thank you for your prayers and support of our ministry. I want to thank the seven churches that participated in our Backyard Kids Clubs and Vacations Bible Schools; you are a blessing to us.

This month we kick off The Doug Sager Center for Preaching and Pastoral Ministry. This is a joint ministry of Carson Newman University and The Jefferson County Baptist Association. The Doug Sager center exists to equip, encourage, and empower Tennessee pastors and ministry leaders for faithful gospel service. This program allows pastors the opportunity to earn a fully-accredited Associate's Degree. I will be teaching Foundations of Servant Leadership beginning Tuesday, August 18 going through Tuesday, October 6. Then Beginning Tuesday, October 20 through Tuesday, December 8 Old Testament and Leadership will be taught. The cost for 3 credit hours for each class is \$450.00.
