The churches of the Jefferson County Baptist Association reported a total of 124 baptisms this year! We want to thank everyone for their hard work to see our neighbors come to faith in Christ as their Lord and Savior.

I am excited to report that we have after school Bible clubs in all eight of our elementary schools. We have had a Good News Club at Dandridge Elementary for many years hosted by First Baptist Church of Dandridge. Buffalo Grove Baptist Church is beginning their third year hosting a Good News Club as well. They meet weekly at Mt. Horeb. We added clubs at Piedmont, Talbott, and White Pine schools in 2024-2025. These are hosted by Piedmont Baptist, Talbott Baptist, and First Baptist Church of White Pine. This year we added Jefferson and New Market elementary schools to the list of Good News Clubs. They have volunteers from Buffalo Grove, East Ridge, Emmanuel, First Baptist Church of Dandridge, Good Hope, Nance's Grove, and Rocky Valley Baptist Church. We also have members of Antioch helping at Talbott and a member from Rocky Valley helping at Mt. Horeb. First Baptist Strawberry Plains also has an after-school outreach program for the children of Rush Strong School. Our Baptist Builders / Disaster Relief provided over four hundred loads firewood to families in need. They delivered numerous truckloads of furniture from God's Warehouse in Morristown to our residents. They built wheelchair ramps for families in Jefferson County and at least one for an elderly couple in Jonesboro, TN. Lastly, our Disaster Relief teams spent over two months helping the residents of Cocke County in their recovery from the flood.

This year was our fifth annual Home Run Derby at New Market and our second one in Dandridge. We were able to register many children for Sunday School and Vacation Bible School. We also had our fifth annual Backyard Kids Club in Reid Town. We then held our second Punt, Pass and Kick contest in July at the Field of Dreams in Dandridge and our first Tea Party for girls in September. Thank you to all the volunteers that made these events possible.

Our Vacation Bible Schools have again been an enormous success, and many children professed faith in Jesus Christ. We held two Lifeway Back Yard Vacation Bible Schools at the Centennial Park in Jefferson City.

The WMU-sponsored prayer retreat was on Monday, August 25, at Nance's Grove Baptist Church. Thank you to all the WMU ladies who helped plan this event. Brother Derrick Woods was the speaker. He shared with us about their homeless ministry, and an offering was taken. The service was a great blessing to all that attended.

I have had the privilege of meeting with students at Carson Newman for weekly prayer starting last spring. We have been joined by five of our pastors and have seen many ministry opportunities arise from this. I first want to mention that we average about five ministerial students from Carson Newman attending our weekly pastors conference on Monday mornings at 10:00 AM. We were also happy to help with a Ministerial Sunday on Sunday, September 21 and had ten students preaching in ten of our churches on that Sunday morning. Several of them are also available and long to preach if your church needs a pulpit supply or Youth Sunday speaker.

In conclusion, this past year had both good times and glad tidings. Through it all, God was with us. If we follow His leadership, 2026 should be another successful year for Jefferson County Baptists. Thank you for allowing me to serve with you.
