

MISSION AND ACTION (2022)

MISSION STATEMENT:

The mission of Equipping the Persecuted is as the name states: to equip our brothers and sisters in any way we can. People in Nigeria are suffering at the hand of terrorists for their faith in Jesus. Sadly, very little is being done to create a lasting solution. That's where we step in. Our goal is to protect, rebuild, and strengthen families in both body and spirit. We are prepared with the resources necessary to respond after an attack within 24 hours. We provide medical aid, food, and a team to pray and comfort victims.

INTERNALLY DISPLACED PERSON SUPPORT: (\$50,000)

When a village is attacked and the people have nowhere to go, they either start or find their way to an IDP (Internally Displaced Persons) camp. This is where people come together to pool their resources and try to survive. Unfortunately, the Nigerian government has denied that such camps even exist so they receive no aid whatsoever.

ADMINISTRATION COSTS:

We support a staff of 40 Nigerians who work on the ground for the ministry, which costs about \$5,000 a month. Other Admin costs include printing, website development, and salary for our small staff here in the states.

SECURITY & AWARENESS TRAINING: (\$20,000)


The damage done to villages is severe but is often repairable, and when a community begins to rebuild, we are right there to help. Depending on the location, it may be financial assistance that we are able to offer, and other times our support comes as providing volunteer security teams with awareness training and equipment, such as protective vests and radios. Lastly, village-wide alarm systems are installed to alert the residents of approaching threats. As a team, we installed 7 of these systems in 2021.

WIDOW & ORPHAN SUPPORT: (\$12,000)

We have contributed to the monthly support of over 100 widows of murdered pastors in Nigeria. In 2023, we will be able to double our support!

ORPHANAGE CAMPUS CONSTRUCTION: (\$300,000)

This year, we completed Phase One of The Fountain of Hope Children's Home. An orphanage equipped to house over 100 children who were orphaned by Islamic terrorists. We purchased the land to begin campus construction during the month of October 2021. Phase Two will continue in 2023.



STATEMENT OF FAITH

Equipping The Persecuted is a non-denominational organization. We are here to assist all persecuted Christians regardless of their denominational affiliation. That being said, this is our statement of faith and guidelines on which we operate:

THE WORD OF GOD

We believe in God the Father, who is an infinite personal spirit, perfect in holiness, wisdom, power, and love. Judd Saul is an award-winning documentary filmmaker, entrepreneur, and missionary who embarked on a call to action in Nigeria in 2011. He and his wife Sherry have 5 children, all of whom witnessed the vision unfold when Grandfather Duane Wessels invited Judd to join him on a mission trip. The trip changed Judd's life forever. He realized the stark reality of the risk and sacrifice facing these people, and a burden was placed on his heart for the lost and persecuted Christians in Nigeria.

Since then, ministering to Nigerians is a part of Judd's life, regularly serving in Nigeria for over ten years, and he continues to visit 2-3 times a year. It was apparent that escalating attacks outpaced the few Christian missions and organizations effectively responding to the attacks. Talking to local ministers and missionaries, Judd decided to start Equipping The Persecuted to quickly respond and help persecuted Christians in need.

The local leadership affirmed that there are effective ways to help persecuted Christians in addition to victim aftercare. A proactive, prevention mission was put together with a team of missionaries and dedicated supporters in order to avert crises - creating the boots on the ground, locally managed Equipping The Persecuted.
