THE CHARGE

Alum knights & gentry must strive to work well with all fellow volunteers and be supportive of each other.

Alum knights & gentry must be dressed in costume from Wednesday at 2:00pm through Saturday at 11:00am. Knights and gentry are expected to dress appropriately for the cold mornings and evenings. Layers are essential!

Tasks will include food serving, field support, kitchen work, set up/break down support, refilling water coolers, etc.

Alum knights & gentry must work a minimum of 8 hours/full day. Alum knights & gentry will sign up for shifts. During the shift they are at work or at the Knights' Watch station waiting for another task.

Alum knights & gentry may spend off hours at the knights' dining table, at the artisan guild, or in their quarters.

Alum knights & gentry may not have guests in their quarters.

Curfew is from 10:00pm – 7:00am. During the curfew hours, alum knights and gentry must be with their chaperones unless on a special assignment.

At the discretion of their parent/chaperone, alum knights and gentry may carry a cell phone. Cell phones must be out of sight of the squires.

Alcohol, drugs, smoking, vaping, aggression, bullying, and any sexual conduct are strictly prohibited.
