


THE HEAD & THE LOAD

In the performance and work related to *The Head & the Load* (2018), Kentridge looked at the underknown history of African porters during World War I. These porters formed supply lines across the continent where machines were untenable and animals were subject to pestilence brought on by insects. Kentridge describes the project:

The Head & the Load is about Africa and Africans in the First World War. That is to say about all the contradictions and paradoxes of colonialism that were heated and compressed by the circumstances of the war. It is about historical incomprehension (and inaudibility and invisibility). The colonial logic towards the black participants could be summed up: "Lest their actions merit recognition, their deeds must not be recorded."

Work related to *The Head & the Load* aims to recognize and record. A gallery installation of the performance *Kaboom!* (2017–18) projects quotes from African journalists (rightly pointing out that African involvement in the war would bring no benefit to their people) and the registers of wartime officials (coldly classifying the porters as dispensable and as mere numbers in accounting ledgers), and recollections calling forth the memory of the many dead porters out of landscapes defined by colonial dominance.



















Exploration

Kentridge's art is often characterized as political, as he frequently addresses issues of social justice, colonialism, and apartheid in his work. His art is also deeply influenced by his upbringing in South Africa, and he often explores themes of memory, identity, and personal history in his pieces. One of Kentridge's most notable artistic techniques is his use of stop-motion animation, which he often combines with charcoal drawings and collages. This creates a distinctive visual style that is both rough and expressive, and captures the handmade quality of his work.

In addition to his animation and drawing, Kentridge has also worked in other media, including sculpture, printmaking, and theater. He has designed sets and costumes for several opera productions, including Mozart's The Magic Flute and Shostakovich's The Nose.

Kentridge's art has been exhibited extensively around the world, including at the Museum of Modern Art in New York, the Tate Modern in London, and the Centre Pompidou in Paris. He has received numerous awards and honors for his work, including the Nyoto Prize in 2010 and the Princess of Auturias Award for the Arts in 2017.Additionally, Kentridge has also worked in theatre productions, creating set designs and directing productions. He collaborated with the Handspring Puppet Company on the play "Moyzeck on the Highweld," which was performed internationally.

In terms of his art style, Kentridge is known for his use of charcoal drawing and stop-motion animation. He often combines elements of both in his work, creating a unique aesthetic. His works are often political in nature, exploring themes of apartheid, colonialism, and social injustice.

Kentridge has also worked on a number of public installations and sculptures, including a series of bronze sculptures in Johannesburg's financial district that depict figures from South Africa's history. He has also been commissioned to create murals and public art pieces in a variety of locations around the world.
















Herbarium Toolkit

Experience the wonders of botany with our comprehensive toolkit, designed to ignite curiosity and creativity in students of all ages. Our toolkit includes everything you need to embark on an exciting herbarium-making journey, right in the comfort of your home.

Plant Rubbings Preamble

- 1. Collect a variety of plants with interesting
- Choose a smooth and thin paper to use for the rubbing. You may also want to tape or clip the paper to the surface to prevent it from moving during the process.
- 3. Place a leaf or flower face down on the paper.
- 4. Hold the paper firmly in place and use a pencil or crayon to rub over the plant. Apply firm but gentle pressure to transfer the texture and shape of the plant onto the paper.
- Rub over the entire surface of the plant, including the stem and veins if desired.
- 6. Remove the plant and admire the finished



MATERIALS

Instructions

These tools play an important role in botanical pressing, helping artists capture the details and form of plants and create accurate and realistic pressed specimens. Please note that hammers are not commonly used in botanical pressing.

Hammer

Hammers are not typically used in botanical pressing. It is not a common tool for this process.



Tweezers


