PPC 2025 Rules for Booking Events/Reserved Courts

Following the recommendations from the survey and due to the record number of members this year, the following procedures are in effect:

Categories for booking: Upper Advanced = 4.25+ players

Advanced = 4.0 players

Intermediate = 3.5 – 3.9 players

Recreational = 3.49 and below players

1. You may only play **ONCE** per day during Club time. The ONLY time not deemed Club Time is **Public Play**

- 2. You may ONLY play 3 EVENTS per week. Members may ONLY play in 1 level per week.
- 3. Only the following are Non-Events: (excluded from the 3 times per week rule are)

Drop-In sessions

Reserved Courts

League and Team Events

Lessons

- 4. Bookings can be made up to 7 days in advance at 3:00 p.m. Members need to book their OWN reservations.
- 5. If you can't attend a previously made reservation you should cancel by 5:00 pm of the day before your session this gives sufficient time for someone from the waitlist to be added in your place and notify the Court Host.
 - "No shows" for events are extremely frustrating for Court Hosts (CH). Not only could a waitlisted member have taken your place, CH has to re-organize the session at the last minute. "No shows" will lose their court booking privileges".
- 6. Reserved Courts Members may only book one court per day. 1 player may book the court and fill in the other players names by the end of the day to maintain the reservation.
- 7. If a reserved or event court has not been occupied within 10 minutes of the scheduled time, it is open to other members of the public (i.e. a 12:00 noon booking that is not claimed by 12:11 PM is open to other members or the public).
- 8. Non-member/Guests must abide by the PPC guest policy/procedures. The person who books the Reserved Court is the "Court Host" for their court and is responsible for ensuring Club rules/procedures are followed. The court Host is also responsible for any non-member/guests completing a waiver (if one is not already on file), collecting the \$10.00 drop-in fee and placing it in the locked cash box in the cabinet.
- 9. Equipment such as Balls and the Ball Machine are not to be used during NON-CLUB times.
- 10. Members who do not follow these rules could lose their CourtReserve booking privileges.
