Show Update

Registration Update

We have sold 41 display spaces to date with 36 exhibitors (2 are marketplace only) - 3 new within the past week Total \$1,025 in registrations to date vs. \$800 total last year (30 exhibitors) We still have room for a few more table spaces if any more registrations come in.

Set Up Update

We will need to keep track of how many tables we get from each location to assure we get things back where they belong Su<u>nday, October 30 - 4 pm</u> - Tables to be returned to clubhouse stacked in room 2 11 eight-foot tables and 13 six-foot tables to be returned to clubhouse, making sure tables borrowed from that room remain separate <u>Monday, October 31 - 10 am</u> - Move tables from room 2 back to the lower level of the clubhouse (must have tables out of room 2 before 11 am)
