Jen Heinz motioned to approve last month's minutes; Dee Knapp seconded.

Good News:

Catherine Hillis is featured in the Community Gallery at The Art Center in Orange this month, "Chasing Light"; there is a reception June 5 at 5:30 pm.

Bill Mann is the featured artist this month at Art First in Fredericksburg—"Art That Makes You Smile." The opening reception is on June 6, from 6 to 9 p.m. Gary Close will be the featured artist in July.

Jen Heinz and Karen O'Donnell have pieces juried into Liberty Town Art's "Black and White Perspective" show this month; it is an all-photography B&W exhibition.

Pete Brown and Karen O'Donnell have pieces juried into FCCA's June show "Artist Choice." Pete has two pieces.

Check out the First Friday events in Fredericksburg. The galleries (and some shops) are open late.

Jim Funk sold two pieces at Culpeper's Peapod, a co-op.

Upcoming Events:

The America Connects mural mosaic "Bloom" will be unveiled June 18 in Minburn, Iowa. LOW artists participated last year in this project. Information about this mural can be found at https://www.muralmosaic.com/bloom/. August 31 is the deadline for submissions for the upcoming mural mosaic, "Gift." The club will order about 20 tiles for those wishing to participate this year. Instructions for the tiles and color palette will be provided.

Check out the contemporary "Material/Mater/Mother" exhibit by Michelle Gagliano at the Les Yeux du Monde gallery in Charlottesville (until June 29).

Colleen Real, who worked in the framing department at Michael's, may conduct a matting and framing workshop in July or August. A sheet for indicating interest was passed around. Maribeth Logan's Creative Gatherings studio may host a workshop on aspects of framing specifically for LOW Arts members.

For its St. Jude's Fundraiser, the Ladies' Golf Association is looking for volunteers to create and donate artwork for the silent auction. The artwork is to be inspired by art created by St. Jude's children. Four inspirational drawings were available to the volunteer artists. The LGA tournament will occur September 17, and artwork should be completed by the end of August. Sue Flores is the contact for the silent auction.

Art Show Planning Update:

Committees are falling into place. Thanks to Linda Kadar for stepping up to take care of the raffle; Dawn Faulkner for stepping up to the kids' (and adult) art activity; Marilyn Davis and Maribeth Logan for taking care of the signage; and Dee Knapp for handling the Giving Table. Still needed is someone to oversee the silent auction on Friday night. Also needed are ideas for the kids' art activity. The auction will be in conjunction with the raffle; as donations are received, determinations will be made as to what goes where. The planning committee meets the third Thursday of the month at 2:00 in meeting room 1 of the Community Center. Begging for donations begins next month so keep in mind how you might help. Silent auction items are of a higher value; 2D and 3D pieces would be appreciated. The raffle will consist of baskets or larger items; themes for baskets will be announced. The Giving Table is for smaller items.

Under consideration are a painting workshop in the style of Frida Kahlo and a field trip to the Virginia Museum of Fine Arts in Richmond to an exhibit of Frida's artwork.

Dee Knapp stated that group rate tickets will be available to the LOW Players' performance of "White Christmas" in November. The club will pay for members' tickets, but guests will have to pay for theirs.

Lisa Spencer-Ballard has graphics ready for the art show. Save the date cards are available. Toni Maltagliati reported that Bill Mann's next article for Lake Currents

will highlight the successful Fareways reception. Lisa won the first-place award, and Mariana Concha placed second and third. She also sold a painting.

Jen Heinz said the club's website includes artist pages, so provide information about yourself to Jen.
