## ART CLASSES, CALL FOR ARTISTS AND OTHER OPPORTUNITIES



Creative Gatherings welcomes Asya Baldwin, an internationally recognized artist whose training began at age seven and continued through college. She will be teaching a variety of classes starting in August.

There are a few spaces available:

Introduction to drawing, and introduction to landscape watercolor teach the basic skills necessary to improve your artistic style.

Intermediate painting classes in oil, acrylic, and watercolor are also offered.

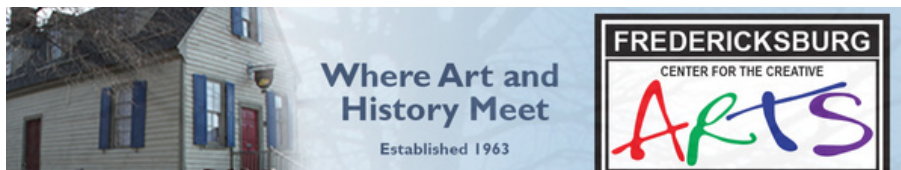
