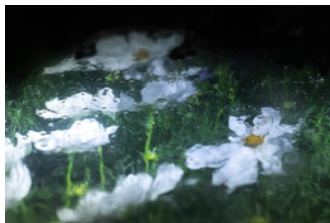

Bill Mann & Pete Brown in Fredericksburg Fine Arts Show

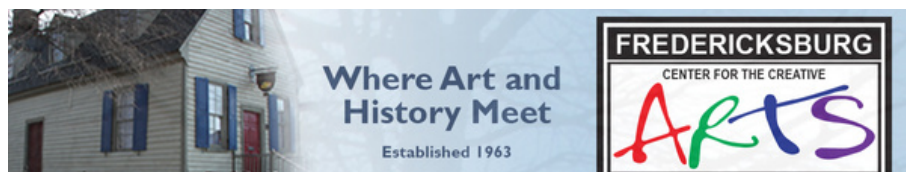
Bill and Pete will have three paintings each in the 74th Fine Arts Show, March 14-16 at the Dorothy Hart Community Center in Fredericksburg.
