

A Social Mission – Galileo for Foster Children

Galileo's robust business model will allow qualified foster students to access Galileo Preparatory Academy free of charge. For every 24 subscribed students enrolled, one student from the foster care system will be enrolled.

There are more than 430,000 children in foster care in the U.S. (3,000 in Middle Tennessee).

About one-third of foster care students change schools at least five times before they reach adulthood.

Each school change is estimated to result in their falling behind their peers by at least a semester.

On average, foster care students reach only a seventh-grade reading level, and only 11 percent of them will complete a bachelor's degree.

Galileo's hybrid learning model will allow for foster care students' education to be uninterrupted regardless of their physical placement.
