Regarding insurance we are currently at \$21 per group per year. The Staten Island area service committee currently owes \$82 which will cover us until October of this year. Our obligation for insurance for 2018 begins in October. Staten Island area service committee needs to do a service inventory and see that we are up-to-date on all meanings in our area are we paying for a correct number of meetings.

The board of directors along with the area chair would like to come to the area service committee meeting and speak to the area. I will be sending this up in the near future. The RSO is in Fair shape. The debt owed to NAWS is \$45,744.00 the debt is being paid in monthly installments of \$4,159.06 beginning July 2017 and it will be paid in 12 monthly payments. Inventory in the regional store is \$86,427.54 so we are doing well. It is very important we purchase literature from region. In regards to a meeting list the RSO charges \$0.05 per meeting list so I asked the literature manager what are current cost is. Going forward or literature picked up at the RSOstore will need to have a check for that order. All orders shipped will have a net 30 payment. All orders over \$500 will be granted a 6% discount. The RSO is asking all areas to allow them to sell merchandise at all of their events.

I have attached the board of directors report please review the attachment. There were three nominations this session first being Fred from Brooklyn for the bod. Secondly was Robin why for the public information chair Who was appointed by the regional chair and we be voted in the next session in September.

There's a GSR assembly being held at the regional office October 21<sup>st</sup> 2017. One Motion in the car report is for zonal seating in the world

service conference currently regions are seated and they are looking to go to zonal seating. An ad hoc committee was formed to discuss with the ABCD and the Mid-Hudson region on how we can share services and how we can help each other creating Unity.

The convention committee is negotiating with the Sheraton Hotel in Long Island to host a convention the target date is sometime in 2019. There was currently \$3,700 in the treasury we are looking for all areas to help out. There are many open commitments such as registration and programming and serenity Keepers and many more commitments. The subcommittee meets the third Thursday at 6 p.m. at 154 Christopher Street.
