REGIONAL ELECTIONS: NEW BOARD OF DIRECTOR MEMBERS VOTED IN JAY M, LEAH H, DAVID M, MARTY B. LOU L SUBMITTED HIS RESUME FOR BOD MEMBER. I ATTACHED IT TO REPORT.

REGIONAL CONCERNS: THE ADHOC COMMITTEE FORMED TO LOOK INTO FINANCIAL SITUATION OF THE RSO AND THE CONVENTION PROCEEDS HAS ISSUED THEIR INITIAL REPORT. THE COMMITTEE CONSISTED OF PAUL W, PETER, LEA H, AND KATHLEEN. IT WAS FOUND THAT THERE WERE NO LARGE AMOUNTS OF MONEY MISSING. THE 48,000 DOLLARS GIVEN TO WS WAS FOR THE 28,000 LOAN FROM WS TO THE RSO FOR LITERATURE PURCHASE AND 20,000 FOR FUTURE LITERATURE ORDERS. THE 28,000 LOAN WAS SHOWN TO BE PAID IN MONTHLY PAYMENTS WAS ACTUALLY NOT PAID BY THE RSO TREASURER BUT RATHER BEING USED TO PURCHASE MORE LITERATURE. THE TREASURER REPORTS GIVEN TO THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS MONTHLY WERE NOT FACTUAL. THERE WAS AN ONGOING DEBT TO NAWA FOR THE PAST 2 YEARS AND THE RSO COULD NOT KEEP UP. IT WAS FOUND THAT LITERATURE WAS BEING PURCHASED THAT WAS NOT SELLING SUCH AS SMALL BASIC TEXTS AND SPECIALIZED ITEMS. AS A RESULT 13,000 WORTH OF LITERATURE WERE ON THE SHELVES NOT ACCOUNTED FOR. ANOTHER REASON FOR THIS IS THE SOFTWARE SYSTEM VEND THAT WAS SUPPOSED TO BE USED TO TRACK INVENTORY, SALES, AND REPORTS WERE NOT BEING USED PROPERLY. IT WAS FOUND THAT DUE TO THE LACK OF VOLUNTEERS TO MANAGE THE RSO THE SAME PEOPLE WERE RUNNING THINGS. AS RESULT OF THIS IT WAS FOUND THAT THE CORPORATE CREDIT CARD USED BY THE RSO OFFICE SHOWED SOME QUESTIONABLE ITEMS IN SMALL AMOUNTS SUCH AS FOOD, GAS, AND TOILETRY ITEMS. OVERALL 4,000 IN CHARGES ARE UNDER REVIEW. A FULL REPORT ON THESE ITEMS IS FORTHCOMING SINCE THE COMMITTEE DID NOT HAVE ENOUGH TIME TO SCRUTINIZE PURCHASES. THE PURPOSE OF THIS CARD WAS TO PAY FOR SUCH THINGS AS POSTAGE FOR LITERATURE ORDERS AND NEEDS OF THE OFFICE SUCH AS PRINTER PAPER, INK, ECT. THIS CARD WAS CANCELLED. THERE WAS A

SECOND CREDIT CARD ISSUED TO THE BOD VICE CHAIR BUT SHOWED NO QUESTIONABLE CHARGES AND REMAINS ACTIVE. THERE WERE NO FINANCIAL POLICY IN PLACE FOR USE OF THE CREDIT CHARGES. NO CREDIT CARD STATEMENTS WERE GIVEN AT THE BOD MEETINGS. IN GENERAL THERE WAS POOR OVERSIGHT BY THE BOD CONCERNING THE BOD TREASURER. I HAVE ATTACHED THE FULL REPORT.
