REGIONAL CONCERNS: Insurance, groups in our region have been questioning why virtual groups need to pay insurance. It was explained by the RSO that the regional insurance policy is by a geographical area and not by individual in person groups. Since it is the area that pays the insurance premium to region if groups in the area do not donate it actually increases the cost for all meetings.

Why should we care about insurance?

Most facilities today have insurance policies that do not extend coverage to organizations to whom they rent their facilities. Often, this is a requirement from their own insurance policies.

As a result, facilities can refuse to rent or lend their available spaces, unless given specific, verifiable assurance of insurance coverage. This coverage would apply to any accidents, injuries, or damage that may occur while their facility is in use by another organization (like an NA Group or Event/Activity).

What kind of insurance assurance / policy is required? These types of policies are called "General Liability Insurance".

What is General Liability Insurance? A standard insurance policy issued to business organizations to protect them against liability claims for bodily injury (BI) and property damage (PD) arising out of premises, operations, products, and completed operations; and advertising and personal injury (PI) liability

How do Groups obtain this coverage?

Because it is very expensive to obtain this coverage on a per-Group basis, the Greater New York Region maintains this insurance policy, through its Regional Service Office, providing this coverage to all the meetings listed as GNYR meetings.

Who pays for the insurance?

Each Area identifying itself as a member of the Greater New York Region pays a monthly amount that is part of the total premium, and is based on the number of meetings that identify themselves as members of that Area. At the July Regional session, the RCMs are requested by the Region to ask their Areas to ensure that their Area's section of the online Regional meeting list is up to date so that the Region has an accurate count of the number of meetings per Area. The sum total is then given to the Insurance Agent who calculates the total yearly premium based on the number of meetings. That information is then given to the Treasurer of the Regional Service Office, who calculates each Area's portion based on the number of meetings in their Area and divides it into 10 (ten) monthly payments. The Areas must begin paying in October (our policy runs yearly from October to October).

Why do Groups need to obtain an Insurance Certificate?

Your meeting may be covered by the GNYR's Insurance Policy but the facility in which your group meets may require proof of this before they allow you to use or continue using their facility.

REGIONAL MEETING: November 13, 2021

REGIONAL DELEGATE REPORT:

GNYRSC RD September RSC Report I. Conference Participant July and August Webinars The RD team attended the conference participant web meetings in July and August, which covered the following topics: • WSC 2022. The World Board made recommendations on holding a limited virtual conference in 2022 (followed by an in person WSC in 2023) that were straw polled at the July and August webinars. The straw polls showed strong support for the recommendations. An e-poll was taken following the August webinar that resulted in overwhelming support for the recommendations, which will now be implemented. Important dates and deadlines will be forthcoming. However, please note that there will be no Conference Agenda Report ("CAR") to workshop at Areas. The only item up for fellowship approval will be the approval draft of the Spiritual Principal a Day book. The results of the e-poll are

attached. • NAWS Financial Update. A financial update of NAWS was provided that showed NA World Services finances are gradually improving but uncertainty still exists regarding future trends. II. NEZF Meetings The RD team attended an NEZF meeting in August where the four project plans previously reported on were approved for implementation. The project plans are 1) development of NEZF guidelines to have clear and complete guidelines, 2) Member participation in NEZF to increase understanding of what the NEZF is, does, and how it connects directly to our fellowship's primary purpose, 3) Online presence plan to increase accessibility to zonal information and resources and 4) Communications project plan to increase effective accessibility and distribution of zonal information and resources. The NEZF Admin Committee is now asking for volunteers to serve on workgroups to carry out the projects. Any interested member may serve on a workgroup by contacting one of the RD team members for further information. The NEZF PR Committee has formed a workgroup to develop a plan to approach the New York State agency responsible for regulating access to institutions to have NA meetings considered an essential service. This information was passed on to the GNYRSC PR chair who is coordinating with NEZF PR on this topic. The RD alternate attended the NEZF Fellowship Development Committee meeting to consider participating in fellowship development efforts. The NEZF FD Committee provides services to our Areas and service requests can be made to NEZF by sending an email to the FD Committee. The Committee has a pool of volunteers with specific experience that they can allocate to service requests. Also, interested members of the GNYR Region with experience can join the pool by submitting a human resources pool form available at fd.nezf.org. Finally, a hybrid NEZF Weekend is taking place in Niagara Falls October 22-24 that can be attended virtually or in person by any interested members. There will be workshops on PR and H&I cooperation, how meetings are dealing with COVID and coordinating services between smaller and larger Regions. III. Facilitation of PSAs Following referrals from the Regional PR chair, the RD looked into how Region Service Offices in the Western states facilitate the placing of PSAs on radio and tv stations in their Regions in cooperation with their Regional and Area PR committees. We were informed that the New Mexico, Arizona and Northern California RSOs have developed a form that services committees can fill out requesting that the RSO submit an application on their behalf to the radio or tv station. The RSO deals directly with the station to submit the application to satisfy the stations' requirement that it is dealing with a formal nonprofit entity, while (by submitting the application directly) the RSO is able to protect from wide dissemination any sensitive corporate information required to be included on the application. The service committee can then submit the PSA directly to the station in coordination with the RSO by providing regular reports to the RSO of its activities. We passed on a sample form used in the Northern California Region to the GNYR RSO Chair with the above explanation for their consideration. We trust that now that the GNYR RSO has a road map for a proven way forward, that they will be able to facilitate GNYR service committees' implementation of carrying out our primary purpose.

NAWS: The 2020 NAWS Annual Report has been posted: www.na.org/ar. Even if you have never looked at one of our annual reports, you'll want to check out this one. For the first time, we are publishing the report digitally. There is also a PDF version for those who prefer to download a document. The Annual Report is the best place to get a full picture of our finances over the course of the fiscal year. This report covers the period 1 July 2019 to 30 June 2020. Because of the complexity of our organization, with branches in five countries with different currencies and the time required for an external audit, it always takes many months for us to produce an annual report. This time the

report is coming out later than usual, primarily because of our continuing staffing shortages. Thank you for your patience. We hope you enjoy the new format.

New Instagram Account for Events: To celebrate reaching more than 10,000 followers on <u>@narcoticsanonymous</u>, we started a new Instagram account <u>@naglobalevents</u> dedicated exclusively to area, regional, zonal, and world events. Send flyers to <u>naglobalevents@na.org</u> and we will post them on Insta and our webpage <u>www.na.org/events</u>.

We can feature event flyers as main posts on @naglobalevents, not just as stories and highlights, as we did on @narcoticsanonymous. For now, we will post events on both accounts, but when @naglobalevents has more followers, we plan to just use that account for event listings. Having an account dedicated to events will free up the stories and highlights on @narcoticsanonymous for clickable items such as new inventory items, new material on the virtual meetings page, audio Basic Texts, and so on. At more than 10,000 followers, we can now include live links on stories and highlights.
