Discussion with the members (Ellen & Jayne) regarding our current policy on voting on motions.

Section E, Item # 11(Page 7-8)

(11) At this point, the GSR'S will be instructed to take the motion back to their groups for discussion and to determine the groups vote on the motion.

1. The motions will be voted on at the next SIASC meeting during old business.

The Area Chairperson will call for a vote on said motion.

At this point, only the vote will be taken. All debates, pros, cons, or questions have been previously addressed at last month's SIASC meeting and will not be entertained. HOWEVER, IF A GROUP HAS A QUESTION, CONCERN OR AN AMENDMENT THAT WAS NOT PREVIOUSLY DISCUSSED, IT CAN BE ASKED TO THE MOTION MAKER ONLY. THERE WILL BE NO OTHER DISCUSSION BETWEEN THE BODY.

We want to ensure that the groups have all of the information so they can make an informed decision on motions to be voted on.

In our current policy, it does not allow for questions, discussions, amendments after the first month. In order to be sure that groups are able to fully participate, once questions, discussions have been asked and answered (at the first month) all information should be brought back to the groups, to be discussed at their business

meetings, if things are not clear the groups should be allowed to ask more questions and make amendments. If there are no questions/amendments it will go to a vote. If there are questions, they will be answered by the motion maker only. A vote will be taken either way.

In short:

If there are no questions/amendments, we will go to a vote the month after the motion hits the floor. If there are questions/amendments that need to go back to the groups, we will go to a vote the second month in order for the groups to be able to get clarification.

The technology committee meets the 4th Tuesday of the month 6:00PM virtually.

Technology committee is still working on :

We will print 1 color copy for a group and 20 black and white at no cost. We would like to be prudent with toner costs.

We will also print on request Sub -committee flyers up to 75 BW. All flyers pdf and JPEG will be on website.

We purchased toner this month. It may seem costly @383.00 Printing is .20 cents for 1 side 40 cents for double. We print 200 meeting lists a month. That's 80.00 a month . just for meeting lists. We spend average 80 on ink and get to print all flyers and booklets. We had to buy the colored ink or the printer wont print. We also must use HP for warranty reasons.

We are starting to use colored paper and black toner to keep costs down.

We billed area 16 for zoom and the rest for the toner with a balance of 100.00 --- we needed a full set of color- our printer came with a starter pack. We chose the XL black which is a little more but double ink. I have all receipts.
