



## 105 Speedway Kart Rules:



### Mandatory Rules:

**ALL Karts** must be numbered and numbers need to be able to be seen on both sides and top of wing.

Karts must have body and closed in front panel.

**Parent or Guardian must be in pit area with driver at all times.**

Will not tolerate rough driving, fighting, arguing with the flag man or track officials, or foul language in pit area or during Kart races. No alcoholic beverages allowed in pit area or during Kart races. This may cause driver to be DQ'd, loss of points and you may be asked to leave immediately.

For safety purposes the driver must have full race gear including suit, full face helmet, gloves, arm restraints, and 5 point harness.

### Mandatory Kart Specs for all Kart classes:

Tires must be tread or turf. (No slicks) Height of tire must not exceed 15".

Fuel must be regular gas only, No race fuels or additives.

Clutch must have chain guard.

No microns will be allowed.

### Rookie Class Karts: 4-8yr olds

Motor must be harbor freight/predator 212 motor 6.5 with red plate **may bypass governor**. No altering of motor except may relocate fuel tank.

May also run the 3.5hp motor. Must be unaltered with no restrictor plate.

Chassis: must be min of 1" diameter. Also must have rub rails between front and rear tires, not to exceed past rear tire and front and rear bumpers.



### **Jr Karts: 8-10yr olds**

Harbor freight/predator 212 motor with blue plate **may bypass governor** . Must be stock with muffler. Will allow relocation of fuel tank.

Chassis: must be min of 1" diameter. Also must have rub rails between front and rear tires, not to exceed past rear tire and front and rear bumpers.

Brakes: Hydraulic or cable

Rear end: Live axle or one wheel

**Standard seat with head guards.**

Weight no less than 230lbs.

### **Senior Karts: 10-16yr olds**

Harbor freight/predator 212 or clone motor. No bigger than 6.5hp.

Open motor no restrictions.

Must run muffler.

Chassis: must be min of 1" diameter. Also must have rub rails between front and rear tires, not to exceed past rear tire and front and rear bumpers.

**Standard seat with head guards.**

Brakes: Hydraulic or cable

Rear end: Live axle or one wheel

Clutch: open gear and clutch

Weight no less than 250lbs.
