The REML Scholarship is to be awarded to a son or daughter of a REML member that is in good standing and a member of the lodge for a minimum of 1 year and Graduating High School to assist with their post-high school education. Post-high school education includes, but is not limited to, technical colleges and schools, community colleges, and universities. Individual awards will be based on the following criteria:

- Applicant has attained at least a 3.0 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale. Please provide school record
- Applicant demonstrates a commitment to participating in a post-secondary program.
- Applicant has exhibited strong leadership, citizenship characteristics & community service.
- Applicant will submit an essay which responds to the following questions:
 1. What is the applicant's plan of action for seeking post-high school education and why?
 2. How is the applicant going to accomplish this plan?
 3. What is the estimated financial cost of this plan?
 4. How will receiving this scholarship impact the applicant's plan?
 5. What do you know about the Loyal Order of Moose?

Essay specifications:

- Essay should not exceed 1000 words
- Essay should be double-spaced & 12-point font size

Eligible Applicants will have at least 1 parent that is a Member in Good Standing of Richmond East Moose Lodge for a minimum of 1 year. Not Grandparent unless they are the custodial guardian.

All applications need to be returned to Richmond East Moose Lodge or Chuck Boyle no later than 5/10/26.
