














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ABOUT PLAN


Architects apply impartial and creative thinking to projects large and small. They add value, whether from maximising light and space, adding functionality, or achieving the best return on your investment. '

Unless your project is very simple, it makes sense to at least talk to an architect for advice before you get going. Generally, architects begin to offer a wider range of services for projects with a budget of £50,000 or more, but for a smaller fee, an architect can help you get the best out of your project in the early stages, regardless of size and whether they are needed later on.

Most architects offer one-off consultations and these can be incredibly useful. They will give you guidance on all aspects of your project from design and cost through to planning and construction. In a short space of time, you can gain valuable insight to help you realise your project.


All architects must be registered with the Architects Registration Board (ARB), with most taking up RIBA membership also. If an individual has neither credential then they may be operating unregulated, providing you with no guarantees of their ability to deliver the service you require.



Farmhouse Remodel, Extension and Outbuilding

The Challenge

- This old Cheshire farmhouse was charming but dysfunctional:
- Dark, small rooms
- Awkward layout (a bedroom only accessible through another, complete with a toilet!)
- Outdated interiors with limited garden views

Our Solution

- We redesigned, extended, and modernised the home while keeping its character:
- Rear extension with sleek open-plan kitchen-diner & lounge
- Improved circulation upstairs to create 3 spacious doubles, including a new master suite with ensuite & dressing area
- Separate snug/office + new utility, WC, and boot room
- Multi-purpose outbuilding including a guest suite

- A bright, modern family home with better flow and function
- Character features retained, but reimagined for contemporary living
- Dramatic increase in value and appeal
- Additional planning secured to convert the adjacent barn into a separate 3-bed home













Green Belt Stone House, Hyde

The Challenge

- Replace a small bungalow with a larger family home
- Secure planning approval on sensitive Green Belt site
- Clients were first-time self-builders

Our Solution

- Designed a 3-bed contemporary stone house with vaulted double-height hallway
- Created generous living spaces: open-plan kitchen/diner/lounge, separate lounge, gym/office
- Maximised natural light with full-height glazing & balconies from every bedroom
- Navigated a complex planning process successfully

- Planning consent granted in Dec 2021
- A striking countryside home, now almost complete
- Spacious, light-filled family home tailored to clients' lifestyle





Cheshire Cottage Remodel and Extension

The Challenge

- 200-year-old cottage with poor layout and small rooms
- Strict limits on extensions in Open Countryside (30% rule)
- Needed more space without losing charm

Our Solution

- Pre-application process to justify 184% size increase
- Designed a large kitchen/diner/lounge with bifold doors & feature fireplace
- Reconfigured upstairs to add a new double bedroom, larger family bathroom, and luxury master suite with walk-through wardrobe
- Added detached double garage with workroom (under Permitted Development)

- Dysfunctional cottage transformed into a functional family home
- Dramatic improvement in garden connection & natural light
- More than doubled property value













Extension and Remodel, Trentham

The Challenge

- Detached Art Deco-style home with cramped kitchen & underused reception rooms
- Need for open-plan family living with more functionality

Our Solution

- Full-width rear extension with large-scale glazing & rooflights
- Internal remodel to create open kitchen-diner & new utility room
- Designed side extension to convert garage into flexible family space
- Materials chosen (Staffordshire brick) to complement & contrast existing render

- Spacious, light-filled family hub with strong Art Deco influence
- Blends heritage style with modern needs
- Nearing completion a striking, characterful home





Extension and remodel, Knutsford

The Challenge

- Outdated 3-bed semi with small galley kitchen & conservatory
- Poor flow and lack of family-friendly spaces
- Needed more usable rooms & better bedroom layouts

Our Solution

- Removed conservatory, added part single/two-storey rear & side extension
- Created a large open-plan kitchen/diner & playroom, plus garden room
- Reconfigured stairs for smoother access
- Upstairs: converted small bedroom into family bathroom, transformed old bathroom into new master suite with ensuite

- A light-filled, functional family home
- Dramatically improved flow and usable space
- Perfect for a growing family (who grew during the build!)











Extension, remodel and Garage Conversion, Northwich

The Challenge

- Beautiful detached home let down by small kitchen & outdated layout
- Separate dining & reception rooms lacked purpose
- Outbuildings blocked views of mature garden

Our Solution

- Knocked through rooms to create a large open-plan kitchen/diner/lounge with crittal-style glazing & feature rooflight
- Converted part of garage into utility/boot room
- Retained character but updated layout
- Secured planning for future dormer loft conversion to create luxury master suite

- Contemporary open-plan living while retaining period charm
- Stronger connection to garden with expansive glazing
- Future-ready design with additional value uplift planned





Extension, remodel and Outbuilding, Knutsford

The Challenge

- Disconnected small rooms and an underused flat-roof garage
- Poor relationship with garden and limited natural light


Our Solution

- Part single/two-storey side & rear extension to replace garage
- Internal remodel creating open-plan kitchen/diner/lounge with corner bifolds
- Added utility, WC & storage
- Modern exterior: white render, timber cladding & outbuilding
- Upstairs: improved bedroom sizes, new family bathroom, luxury master suite with ensuite & dressing area

- A bright, modern family home with seamless garden connection
- Unique character inside and out
- A dramatic before-and-after transformation


