Through hands-on instruction, participants will become familiar with the fundamentals of weaving by beginning with paper – then learning to work with simple looms, incorporating fabric, yarn & beads. As the class progresses, students will experiment with texture and pattern to design unique pieces, from simple textiles to decorative works. This class will provide the unique opportunity to develop both technical skills and artistic expression in fiber arts.
