This workshop was limited by when we had access to a kiln for the firing (and the 3 days required to do the firing!), so all pieces will be returned to the students as fully fired bisqueware – NOT glazed, but ready for them to paint when they take them home! Those fired pieces will be collected at the Hays Arts Center the following week.
