

Hello Club members!

The LOCC and the Lake Regional Hospital Cancer Center in Osage Beach is teaming up again to recognize Cancer survivors and supporters with a Survivor Day Celebration on 7 June, 2026 from 9 to 11 AM. This celebration event is to honor survivors of this deadly disease. Our participation is to provide this celebration day with an internal (LOCC only) car show, “Corvettes Against Cancer”. This is a public event but only LOCC members cars can compete.

Location: Lake Regional Hospital Cancer Center, 54 Hospital Dr, Osage Beach (Lot F).

The purpose of the event is to show our support to the Lake Regional Cancer Center and all the work they do by raising donations either by voting at the show or on line. Members will present their beautiful cars in a “friendly” show of competition with plaques being awarded

Activities include:

- Celebrate Survivorship program by Lake Regional Cancer Center
- Corvette car show with voting options
- Cancer Center tours
- Free gift for survivors
- Hospital will provide food/refreshments

Cancer survivors, the public and online donations will be the judges!

Each car will have a sealed container (slot on top for ticket drop) and will be judged in specific categories:

- **Best In Show** - voted on by the survivors who will be provided voting tickets by the hospital and also the public will be able to vote by making a donation for tickets sold at the show (\$1 = one ticket, one vote or \$5 for 6 tickets, 6 votes)

- o This category is the total number of combined tickets (survivor and public). This car must be at the show.
- o It is also eligible for MOST FUNDRAISER award as well.
- **Most Overall Fundraiser** – The car must be registered on line and participating at the show.
 - o A combination of online donations and “at the show” money donations. The car that receives the most \$\$ overall will win this award.
- **Survivor Pick** -
 - o The most “survivor” tickets at the show.
- **Public Pick** -
 - o The most public tickets at the show.

PLEASE NOTE:

- A car can win BEST OF SHOW and also MOST OVERALL FUNDRAISER

award. This car will be omitted from all other categories.

- A car can win both the survivor and public awards depending on the number of tickets received.

The agenda looks like this:

- 8 AM - Cars begin to arrive to set up. Hospital stand (survivor registration and ticketing) and LOCC stand (to purchase public tickets) will set up
- 9 AM - Show starts.
- 11 AM - Plaques awarded

There are NO REGISTRATION FEES!! We would like to have as many cars present but you don't have to be there to participate in the show competition. EVERY car in our club can register "on line" and become a fundraiser. Once registered, you can share your page link to your family and friends and they can vote by donating money (\$1 = 1 vote) on your fundraiser page.

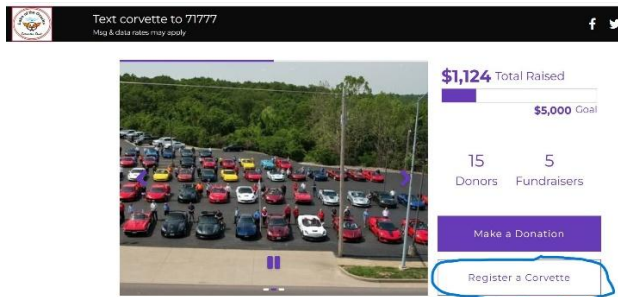
Registration instructions are below. Very simple!!! If you registered your car last year, you will see it already on the website.

Car Registration:

NOTE: YOU DON'T HAVE TO "REGISTER" YOUR CAR IF YOU REGISTERED LAST YEAR!! Disregard these steps. However, if you want to increase your goal the application may do it. If it doesn't, please contact me with the new goal amount and I'll get it changed.

1. Go to:

2. On the registration page, fill in all the areas (NOTE: address not required for registration but highly encouraged. OMIT the "Car Class" drop down

Drive out cancer and celebrate survivors. Register your Corvette for the Corvettes Against Cancer car show and become a fundraiser for non-profit health care at Lake Regional Cancer Center.

Set your fundraising goal, upload your best Corvette photo and personalize your page. Share with friends and family! Every \$1 = 1 vote.

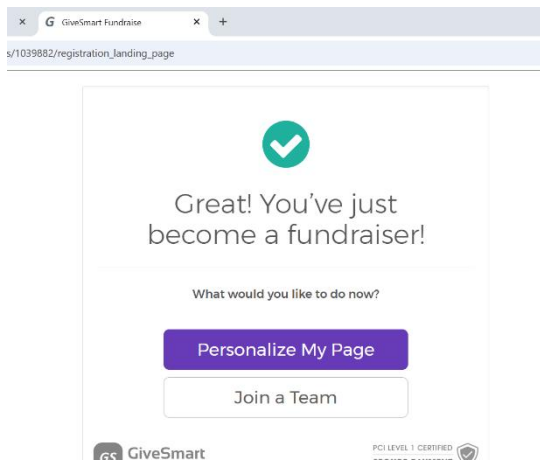

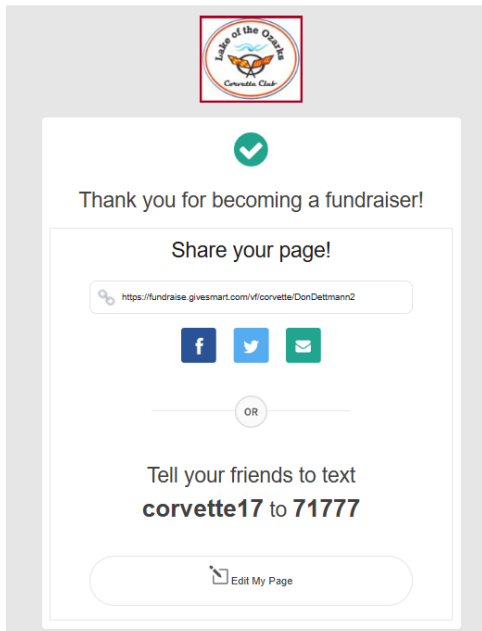

3. Click the “register” button. It will come back to you saying, “Great! You’ve just become a fundraiser”. Click on “Personalize my page”.



4. You will also receive an email from the hospital that will provide additional instructions. Subject: Your Fundraising Page Is Ready. This page will provide you with a personal link to your page. Share this link with your potential donors. **NOTE: keep this**

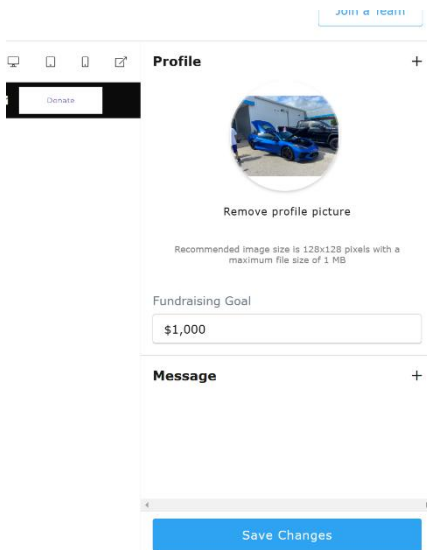
email. You will need it if you require editing in the future.



5. Click on “Edit My Page”

a. Go to the right of the page and click on the profile “+”

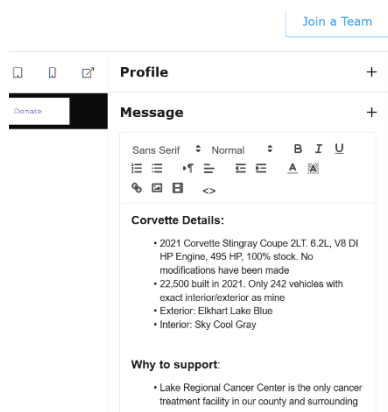
i. Add your car picture (one picture only)



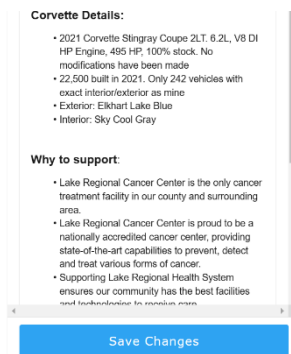
b. Create your fundraising goal.

c. Go to the message on the right of the page and click on the “+”

i. Just above “Why To Support”, Add a paragraph and mention any car details you wish (i.e. make, model, year, color, etc)



d. Once completed, click on the “Save Changes” button



6. You're done!!

NOTE: Once a person has registered, the system will assign them a number. Example: They'll be 'corvette1', the next person will be assigned 'corvette2'.

This gives you an easy way to share their own page, instead of the main page.

Someone could text: **corvette1** to **71777** and be taken directly to their page to “vote”, i.e., donate.

Also, once the person is signed up, they’ll get an email from the system that will take them to their page. The icons on the page, make it easy to share with others.

Anytime a person gets a donation, they are notified by text that a donation came to their page.
