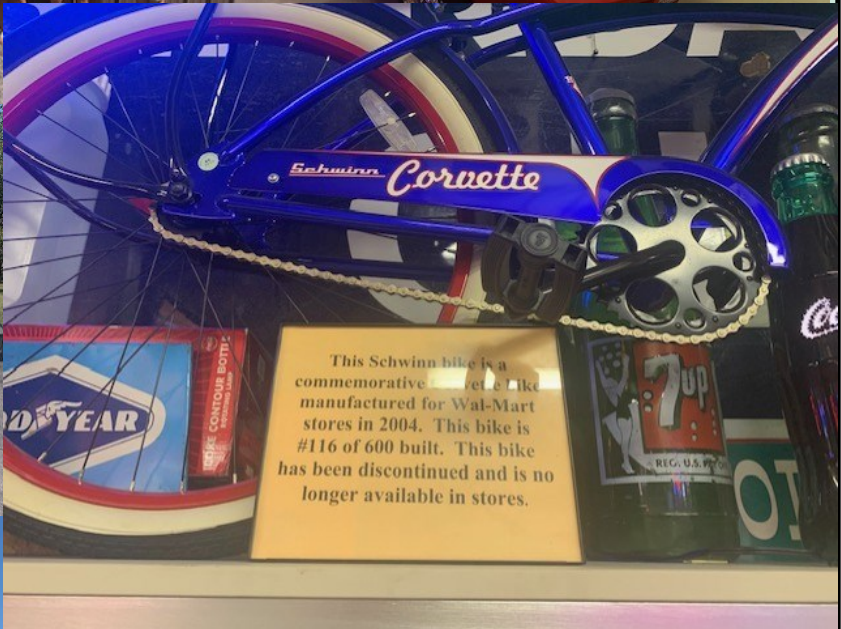

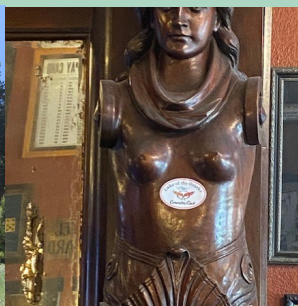
Thanks for Playing "Where in the World is LOCC?"!

Here are some of my highlights from 2025:

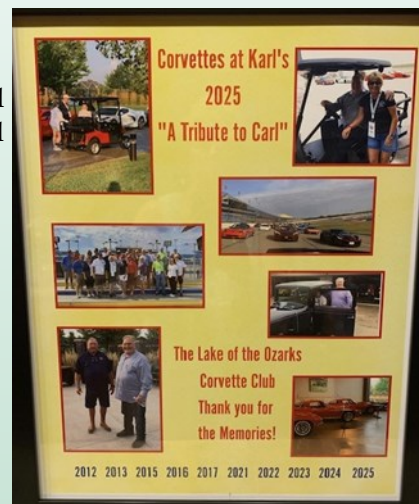
