Corvette Trivia:

What year did the price of a new Corvette break \$ 20,000?

In 1982, the base price of the Collector's Edition reached an MSRP of \$ 22, 537.59. Interestingly, the C4 Corvette debuted two years later at a base price of \$ 21,800. In contrast, starting MSRP for a 2024 Stingray is \$68,300. The 1982 base also put out 200 hp vs. 495 hp in the 2024.
