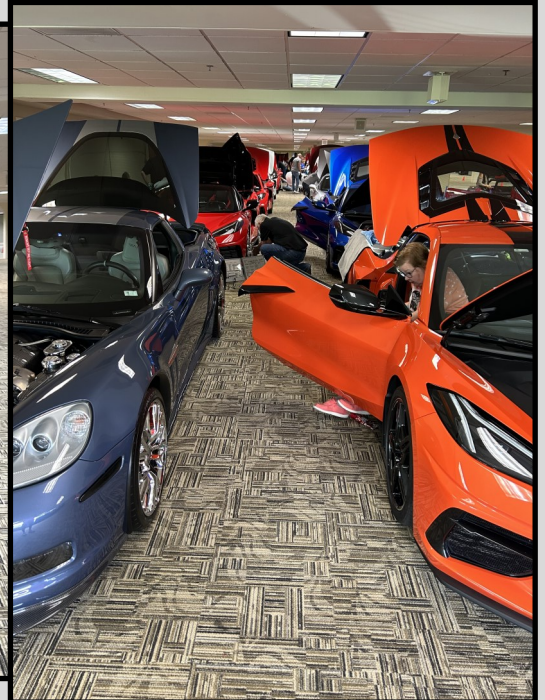
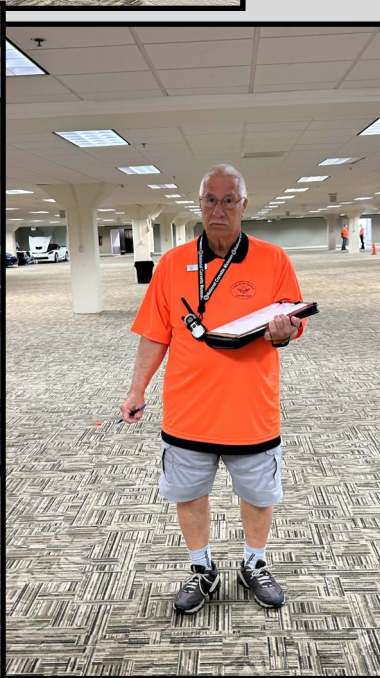
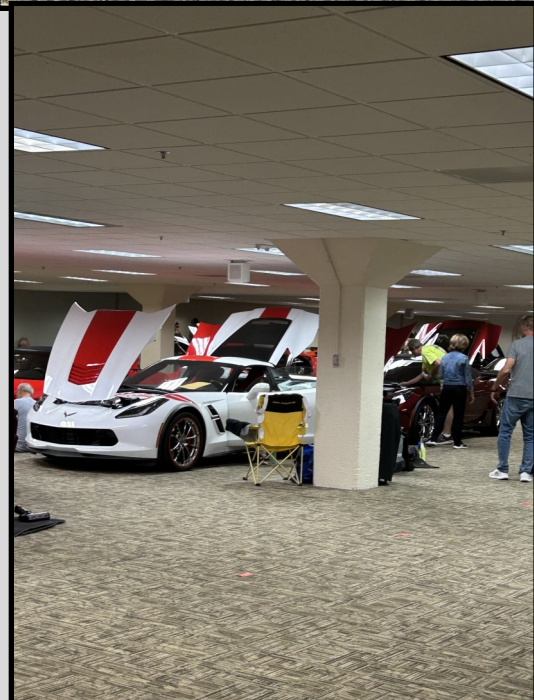
CORVETTES ROLL IN FOR INDOOR PARKING FRIDAY, APRIL 28, 2023

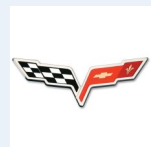

Corvettes in Paradise Nets \$19,950 For Local Lake Area Charities

In it's third year, the CiP show has almost quadrupled the amount of monetary donations made to our local charities since the first show in 2021.
