7.1 President

Another busy Month for our Executive, following up on previous issues and responsibilities as well as picking up on new ones. Again, a big thank you to our Executive Members including Club Delegates for your efforts.

7.1.1 Representative Team

1st item for discussion is our Representative trip to Tamworth. We have appointed our Manager, Umpire and Scorer to represent our Association and Team in Tamworth, Deborah Hoogers is going as Manager, Steve McLean is going as Umpire and Jessica Grant is going as Scorer. A big thank you to all three for giving us their time and effort to help make this trip happen. Our Shirts have been ordered and half paid for, with the other half due upon completion. We are expecting delivery of these by the 1st of June, once they show up we will either distribute them before the team leaves or get them handed out on the trip by the coaches. The same goes for the hats which have also been ordered and paid for and should show up around the same date. Our lovely Secretary Sarah Bloomfield has created the Wagga Baseball Website which will hopefully circulate to generate more interest for our local competition. On this website is a link for the players to pay their itemised fees for the trip directly into the Wagga Baseball account which makes things much easier. The team has changed the training time to start later, on Saturday's at 2pm to suit more people which has helped get more players to attend, as we only have a few weeks left we really need to start training properly to get ready for the trip. This is being communicated to the players through face to face interaction as well as through our messenger chat group.

Our fundraising efforts have been ongoing since the last meeting, with the last of the chocolate money dribbling in, as well as a few BBQs being run by the Association/Rep Team on Gamedays, thank you to the Bulls and Red Sox clubs for donating their days to raise this money. We have also ran a couple of 100 club raffles to raise a bit extra which seem to be working fairly well as they are decent money for minimal effort. These will continue, to raise as much as we can for this trip and beyond. Scott Hawkins has floated an idea of hosting a poker night at somebody's house to raise more money, something like a \$40 buy in with half being the winners kitty and the rest going to Wagga Baseball, can the club delegates float this idea with their respective clubs to gauge interest and decide if this will/should go ahead?

We have distributed a few Sponsorship letters to local businesses but need to send more out. I have attached the letter to this report/agenda for perusal, if anybody can think of more people/businesses we can target please let us know so we can jump on it and try to get something organised. So far, the people we have approached have not responded but they will be chased over the next week or so, by the time this meeting goes ahead I hope to have some good news regarding one or more of these potential sponsors. We feel we have put together some good offers to businesses for their money so hopefully we can get some people on board.



As discussed at the last meeting, our players need to have signed the Code of Conduct, can each club delegate confirm this has happened please.

With some colder weather recently as well as some rain the Black Diamond is starting to show signs of wear and tear, I will be talking with a few of our members about what to do to try to keep both fields in the best possible shape moving forward through this season, floating ideas of what we can do to keep both mounds in shape and fix the batters and catchers boxes on both diamonds. I have taken over chasing the Council for the cut-outs which I will be doing over the next few weeks, given how late we are already in this season, this is to get the fields more suitable by next season realistically.

A reminder to everybody to please like and share as many posts as possible from our 'Wagga Baseball' Facebook page, as well as the page 'Friends of Wagga Baseball'. The more we get our name out there the better it will be. The Match Reports in the paper have been circulating also which is great to see, I have also seen the TV cameras at Baseball again the last two weeks which will also help our cause for advertising. An idea has been floated to me that we should make up a temporary sign to hang on the fence facing the Red Hill road/Bourke street roundabout saying we are playing baseball and have a BBQ on if people want to come watch, displaying the menu and price list of course. I like the logic and am of the opinion it's easier to seek forgiveness than ask permission in this case but would like feedback from everybody before proceeding. On Sunday, we actually had a member of the public come by to buy some food from the BBQ and watched the end of the 1st game, if we can get people interested like that it could help as well.

Thanks again to everybody for their efforts this season so far, there is still plenty to be done but we are getting through most of it.

7.7 Competitions
