We will need to gather rough numbers for our scoring clinic to organise with NSWCSA. Currently we are looking towards time in March. We need a minimum number of 6 people preferably more. With this training we will be able to conduct our own entry level accreditations within the association.

We have clarified that if we have 6-7 teams we will play 1 round as 1 grade and then separate into 2 grades.

6 Teams

Option 1 - 2 grades of 3, 1 team of each grade having a bye every week for rounds 2 & up utilising only 1 ground for those rounds.

Option 2 - 2 grades of 3, 1 week A grade double header the next week B grade double header to maximise number of games for playing members

Finals

- 1. 2v3 and 1 straight through
- 2. 1v2 Winner straight through, the loser v 3 and winner plays winner of 1v2.

7 Teams

Option 1 - 2 grades 1 of 3 and 1 of 4, 1 team of the 3 team grade having a bye every week for rounds 2 & up

Option 2 - 2 grades 1 of 3 and 1 of 4, 3 team grade having double headers every week for rounds 2 & up

Do we determine which grades will have 3 and 4 teams when we decide to separate into the grades. Which option for finals for the 3 team grade.
