Should players or coaches have serious issues with the umpiring on a particular day you need to put a complaint in writing so we can assess the situation and decide if any action needs to be taken. If you blow up and go to far it will be you that is punished regardless of the decision that lead to it. Act like an adult, accept the decision of the umpire and control your emotions!
