CEBA Now Open to Businesses Operating under Personal Accounts:

Farmers and other small businesses that have been operating out of a non-business banking account can now access the Canada Emergency Business Account (CEBA) by opening a business account.



I have heard from many of you about this issue, and I have continued to advocate for this necessary change. This announcement comes far too late, and I must also note that to be eligible, businesses must have been operating as a business as of March 1, 2020, must successfully open a business account at a Canadian financial institution that is participating in CEBA, and meet the other existing CEBA eligibility criteria.

The extended deadline to apply for CEBA is December 31, 2020.
