United we stand, Divided we fall
Respect other rebels' right to privacy and the confidentiality of their personal information. This is a safe space where we can share and trust that it will remain private.

Act with honesty and integrity when dealing with property, monies and any other assets belonging to the Rebel Heart Retreats
