RULES OF GOLF

RULE 2.5

Claims in Match Play

If a doubt or dispute arises between the players and no duly authorized representative of the Committee is available within a reasonable time, the players shall continue the match without delay. A claim must be made to your opponents before any players plays from the new teeing ground, and the claim may be brought to the committee at the end of the round. In match play, playing a second ball when in doubt as to procedure is never appropriate. A second ball thus played is a 'wrong ball' and would result in loss of hole by the player.
